(2 or more may be required, 1 must include photo)***

ALL US CITIZENS BORN IN THE STATES

Drivers License or State Issued ID

***U.S. Passport**

***Birth Certificate**

**** - As of January 1st, 2012 all citizens born in the U.S. must provide either a U.S. Passport or Birth Certificate at time of fingerprinting. A Social Security Card is no longer acceptable as a primary form of ID.***
