I. CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL:

The November 6, 2025 meeting of the CITIZENS' COMMITTEE ON AIRPORT NOISE (CCAN) was called to order at 6:00 p.m. The following Committee members were present: JOHN ALFORD, ALICE MCLANE, VICTORIA CHOURIS, MARTIN KLEIN, TERESA JOHNSON, HENRY PAWSKI, LEW CRAMPTON and NANCY PULLUM. Additionally, nearly 100 individuals from the neighborhoods surrounding Palm Beach International Airport (PBI) and from the Town of Palm Beach attended the meeting.

CHAIRPERSON NANCY PULLUM welcomed the members of the general public and provided a general explanation of the CCAN. She advised that there was no advance notice given to the CCAN regarding a recent decision to impose a temporary flight restriction (TFR) around Mar-a-Lago in Palm Beach, FL. She also informed them that the meeting was being live-streamed on the Palm Beach County's Facebook page and via Youtube.

Director of Airports, Laura Beebe addressed those in attendance. She introduced Gary Sypek, Senior Deputy Director of Airports, Assistant County Attorney Anne Helfant and Steve Osit.

Both Laura Beebe and Gary Sypek presented information regarding a recent decision by the federal government to impose a temporary flight restriction (TFR) around Mar-a-Lago in Palm Beach, FL. The presentation included information regarding the roles and responsibilities of the Department of Airports, an overview of the airfield configuration at Palm Beach International Airport and a detailed explanation of how a TFR would impact air traffic and when and why a TFR is implemented.

Meeting attendees were provided the opportunity to speak. Twenty-two members of local communities, including elected officials, voiced their opinions regarding the recent decision to impose the TFR.
