I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: First Amendment (Amendment) to Maintenance/Service Agreement (Agreement) with HUB Parking Technology USA, Inc. (HUB) (R-2018-0040), providing for the maintenance of the parking and revenue control system (PARCS) at Palm Beach International Airport (PBI), extension of the term of the Agreement by five additional years to December 31, 2027, the update of components of the PARCS, and an increase in the total not to exceed amount by \$1,604,124.37.

Summary: The Agreement provides for the maintenance, repair and support services for proprietary equipment and software installed by HUB that is used to control access, collect revenue, report, and monitor public parking operations at PBI. HUB is located in Warrendale, Pennsylvania. The Agreement has an initial term of five years, expiring on December 31, 2022, with no further renewal options. This Amendment extends the term of the Agreement for an additional five years to December 31, 2027. The total contract amount for the initial term of the Agreement was \$1,415,101. The total contract amount for the five-year extension is \$1,604,124.37. This project is fully budgeted in FY 2023 Budget. The PARCS and all of its components are proprietary to HUB and cannot be supported by any other company. Approval of this Amendment will allow HUB to continue to provide emergency services, maintenance and support of the PARCS. In addition to routine system maintenance, HUB will update components of the system to extend the life of the PARCS. HUB is the sole source service and support provider for the PARCS installed at PBI; therefore, the Agreement is not subject to the Affirmative Procurement Initiatives (API) for S/M/WBE participation. Pursuant to changes to Chapter 332, Florida Statutes, a governing body of a commercial service airport may not approve purchases of contractual services in excess of the Category Five threshold amount of \$325,000 established by Section 287.017, Florida Statutes, on a consent agenda. This Amendment exceeds the threshold amount and must be approved on the regular agenda. Countywide (AH)

Background and Policy Issues: In 2008, the County selected HUB (formerly CTR Systems) pursuant to a Request for Proposals for the installation and maintenance of a PARCS (R-2008-0172). On January 23, 2018, the Board approved the Agreement for continued maintenance of the PARCS by HUB (R-2018-0040). In addition to extending the term of Agreement, approval of this Amendment will provide for additional equipment and programming, including upgrades to support the interface of chip and pin credit card software provided by others, network switches and exit booth upgrades at the main exit plaza.

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO
HUB PARKING TECHNOLOGY USA INC.
MAINTENANCE/SERVICE AGREEMENT**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE MAINTENANCE/SERVICE AGREEMENT (this "Amendment"), dated NOV 15 2022, 2022 is made by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners ("Customer"), and HUB PARKING TECHNOLOGY USA, INC., a Delaware corporation, having its office and principal place of business at 761 Commonwealth Drive, Suite 204, Warrendale, PA, 15086 ("HUB").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Customer, by and through its Department of Airports ("Department"), owns and operates Palm Beach International Airport ("PBI"), located in Palm Beach County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Customer entered into that certain Contract for the installation of a parking and revenue control system ("PARCS") by CTR Systems Parking, Inc. (R-2008-0172) ("CTR") at PBI; and

WHEREAS, HUB acquired CTR in 2013 and is the sole source manufacturer and supplier of the PARCS installed at PBI; and

WHEREAS, the parties have entered into that certain Maintenance/Service Agreement dated January 23, 2018 ("Agreement") (R-2018-0040), for the continued maintenance and repair of the PARCS, which the parties acknowledge and agree expires December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to extend the term of the Agreement and amend the Agreement in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth herein. .

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements expressed herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference. Terms not defined herein shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Agreement. For purposes of this Amendment, the term "Section" shall refer to the numbered paragraphs in the Agreement.

2. Contract Representatives. Customer's representative/liaison during the performance of the Extended Term shall be Director of Airport Properties, who may be contacted at the following: (561) 471 – 7472 (telephone), and slarose@pbia.org (e-mail) ("Customer's Representative"). HUB's representative/liaison during the performance of this Amendment shall be Roger Slayton, who may be contacted at the following: (844) 482 – 7275, extension 5125 (telephone), and Roger.Slayton@hubparking.com (e-mail). Either party may change the designated representative/liaison upon three (3) days prior written notice to the other party.

3. Extended Term. The term of the Agreement is hereby extended for an additional five (5) years, commencing on January 1, 2023, and expiring on December 31, 2027 ("Extended Term").

4. Basic Maintenance Services. The total amount to be paid by Customer for Basic Maintenance Services during the Extended Term shall not exceed Seven Hundred Fifty-Seven Thousand, One Hundred Forty-Five Dollars and Seven Cents (\$757,145.07) in accordance with the fee schedule set forth below. Customer shall continue to make payments on a quarterly basis as provided for in the Agreement during the Extended Term. The term "Contract Year" means a twelve (12) month period commencing on January 1st of each year and ending on December 31st.

5. Renewal and Replacement. In addition to Basic Maintenance Services, HUB shall complete the renewal and replacement projects set forth in the proposals attached hereto and incorporated into this Amendment as Exhibits 1-A through 1-H, and as further summarized in the table below (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Projects", and individually as a "Project"). HUB shall not commence work on a Project until receipt of a written Notice to Proceed ("NTP") from Customer Representative. Upon receipt of a NTP, HUB shall commence and complete the Project in accordance with a schedule approved in advance by the Customer. The amount to be paid by Customer for each Project shall not exceed the amount listed in the table below for a total not to exceed amount of Seven Hundred Forty-Six Thousand, Nine Hundred Seventy-Nine Dollars and Thirty Cents (\$746,979.30). Except as otherwise provided for herein, payment for the Projects will be made in accordance with the terms and conditions of the proposals as set forth in Exhibits 1-A through 1-H. For Projects requiring partial advance payment, HUB shall submit an invoice to Customer for the final payment upon completion of the Project. Invoices received from HUB pursuant to this Agreement will be reviewed and approved by the County's Representative prior to payment to verify that services have been rendered in conformity with the Agreement. Invoices will normally be paid within thirty (30) days following the County Representative's approval in accordance with the Florida Prompt Payment Act. Interest penalties will be paid by Customer in accordance with the Florida Prompt Payment Act, Florida Statute 218.70 notwithstanding any provision of the Agreement to the contrary.

6. Additional Services/Equipment. The parties acknowledge and agree that additional services and equipment may be required during the Extended Agreement, which may include, but is not limited to, infrastructure, network, hardware, firmware and software ("Additional Services"). HUB shall submit a written proposal for all Additional Services requested by Customer for review and approval by Customer Representative and the Department's Deputy Director of Finance and Administration. In the event Additional Services are approved in writing by the

Customer's Representative and Department's Deputy Director of Finance and Administration, the Additional Services shall be completed in accordance with a schedule approved in advance by Customer. During the Extended Term, the total cost of Additional Services shall not exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$100,000.00).

7. Total Contract Not to Exceed Amount. The total cost of all services and equipment provided under this Agreement, including for the Basic Maintenance Services, the Projects and Additional Services, shall not exceed One Million, Six Hundred Four Thousand, One Hundred Twenty-Four Dollars and Thirty-Seven Cents (\$1,604,124.37).

8. Federal Nondiscrimination Requirements. In addition to the nondiscrimination requirements set forth in Paragraph 15 of the Agreement, HUB agrees to comply with the federal nondiscrimination provisions set forth in Exhibit "2" to this Amendment.

9. Termination. Section 7, Default, of the Agreement is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

7. Termination

This Agreement may be terminated by HUB upon thirty (30) business days' prior written notice to Customer in the event of a material default by Customer to perform in accordance with the terms of this Agreement through no fault of HUB and such default is not cured by Customer within the thirty (30) business days. This Agreement may also be terminated, in whole or in part, by Customer, with cause upon five (5) business days' written notice to HUB or without cause upon ninety (90) days' written notice to HUB as provided in Section 1 of the Agreement ("Termination Notice"). Unless HUB is in default of this Agreement, HUB shall be paid for services rendered through the date of termination. After receipt of a Termination Notice, except as otherwise directed by Customer, in writing, HUB shall:

- A. Stop work on the date and to the extent specified.
- B. Terminate and settle all orders and subcontracts relating to the performance of the terminated work.
- C. Transfer all work in process, completed work, and other materials related to the terminated work to Customer.
- D. Continue and complete all parts of the work that have not been terminated.

10. Insurance. Section 13, Insurance Required, of the Agreement is hereby amended to delete the first paragraph in its entirety and replace it with the following:

HUB shall maintain at its sole expense, in full force and effect, at all times during the term of this Agreement, insurance coverage and limits (including endorsements) as described herein. Failure to maintain the required insurance shall be considered default of the Agreement. The requirements contained herein, as well as Customer's review or acceptance of insurance maintained by HUB, are not intended to and shall not in any manner limit or qualify the liabilities and obligations assumed by HUB under the Agreement. HUB agrees to notify

Customer at least ten (10) days prior to cancellation, non-renewal or material change to the required insurance coverage. Where applicable, coverage shall apply on a primary basis.

11. Insurance. Section 13, **Insurance Required**, of the Agreement is hereby amended to delete the fifth paragraph in its entirety and replace it with the following:

Prior to execution of this Agreement, extension of this Agreement, within forty-eight (48) hours of a request by Customer, and upon expiration of any of the required coverage throughout the Term of this Agreement, including the Extended Term, HUB shall deliver to Customer or Customer's designated representative a signed Certificate(s) of Insurance evidencing that all types and minimum limits of insurance coverage required by this Agreement have been obtained and are in force and effect. Certificates shall be issued to:

12. Public Records, Access and Audits. The Agreement is hereby amended to add the following Section 16:

16. Public Records, Access and Audits.

HUB shall maintain records related to all charges, expenses, and costs incurred in estimating and performing the work for at least five (5) years after completion or termination of this Agreement. Customer shall have access to such records as required in this section for the purpose of inspection or audit during normal business hours, at HUB's place of business.

Notwithstanding anything contained herein, as provided under Section 119.0701, F.S., if the HUB: (i) provides a service; and (ii) acts on behalf of Customer as provided under Section 119.011(2), F.S., HUB shall comply with the requirements of Section 119.0701, Florida Statutes, as it may be amended from time to time. HUB is specifically required to:

- A. Keep and maintain public records required by Customer to perform services as provided under this Agreement.
- B. Upon request from Customer's Custodian of Public Records ("Custodian") or Customer's Representative, on behalf of Custodian, provide Customer with a copy of the requested records or allow the records to be inspected or copied within a reasonable time at a cost that does not exceed the cost provided in Chapter 119 or as otherwise provided by law. HUB further agrees that all fees, charges and expenses shall be determined in accordance with Palm Beach County PPM CW-F-002, Fees Associated with Public Records Requests, as it may be amended or replaced from time to time.

- C. Ensure that public records that are exempt, or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements are not disclosed except as authorized by law for the duration of the Agreement term and following completion of the Agreement, if HUB does not transfer the records to the public agency. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the disclosure of or the provision of records to Customer.
- D. Upon completion of this Agreement, HUB shall transfer, at no cost to Customer, all public records in possession of HUB unless notified by Customer's Representative, on behalf of Customer's Custodian, to keep and maintain public records required by Customer to perform the service. If HUB transfers all public records to Customer upon completion of the Agreement, HUB shall destroy any duplicate public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements. If HUB keeps and maintains public records upon completion of this Agreement, HUB shall meet all applicable requirements for retaining public records. All records stored electronically by HUB must be provided to Customer upon request of Customer's Custodian or Customer's Representative, on behalf of Customer's Custodian, in a format that is compatible with the information technology systems of Customer, at no cost to Customer.

HUB acknowledges that it has familiarized itself with the requirements of Chapter 119, F.S., and other requirements of state law applicable to public records not specifically set forth herein. Failure of HUB to comply with the requirements of this Section, Chapter 119, F.S. and other applicable requirements of state law shall be a material breach of this Agreement. Customer shall have the right to exercise any and all remedies available to it for breach of contract, including but not limited to, the right to terminate for cause.

IF HUB HAS QUESTIONS REGARDING THE APPLICATION OF CHAPTER 119, FLORIDA STATUTES, TO HUB'S DUTY TO PROVIDE PUBLIC RECORDS RELATING TO THIS AGREEMENT, PLEASE CONTACT THE CUSTODIAN OF PUBLIC RECORDS AT RECORDS REQUEST, PALM BEACH COUNTY PUBLIC AFFAIRS DEPARTMENT, 301 N. OLIVE AVENUE, WEST PALM BEACH, FL 33401, BY E-MAIL AT RECORDSREQUEST@PBCGOV.ORG OR BY TELEPHONE AT 561-355-6680."

13. Public Records, Access and Audits. The Agreement is hereby amended to add the following Section 17, which shall also constitute HUB's certification required at the time of extension of this Agreement:

17. Scrutinized Companies.

- A. As provided in F.S. 287.135, by entering into this Agreement or performing any work in furtherance hereof, HUB certifies that it, its affiliates, suppliers, subcontractors and consultants who will perform hereunder, have not been placed on the Scrutinized Companies that Boycott Israel List or is engaged in a boycott of Israel, pursuant to F.S. 215.4725. Pursuant to F.S. 287.135(3)(b), if HUB is found to have been placed on the Scrutinized

Companies that Boycott Israel List or is engaged in a boycott of Israel, this Agreement may be terminated at the option of Customer.

- B. **When contract value is greater than \$1 million:** As provided in F.S. 287.135, by entering into this Agreement or performing any work in furtherance hereof, HUB certifies that it, its affiliates, suppliers, subcontractors and consultants who will perform hereunder, have not been placed on the Scrutinized Companies With Activities in Sudan List or Scrutinized Companies With Activities in The Iran Petroleum Energy Sector List created pursuant to F.S. 215.473 or is engaged in business operations in Cuba or Syria.
- C. If Customer determines, using credible information available to the public, that a false certification has been submitted by HUB, this Agreement may be terminated and a civil penalty equal to the greater of \$2 million or twice the amount of this Agreement shall be imposed, pursuant to F.S. 287.135. Said certification must also be submitted at the time of Agreement renewal.

14. E-Verify – Employment Eligibility. The Agreement is hereby amended to add the following Section 18:

18. E-Verify – Employment Eligibility

HUB warrants and represents that it is in compliance with section 448.095, Florida Statutes, as may be amended, and that it: (1) is registered with the E-Verify System (E-Verify.gov), and that it uses the E-Verify System to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers; and (2) has verified that all of HUB's subcontractor's performing the duties and obligations of this Agreement are registered with the E-Verify System, and use the E-Verify System to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers.

HUB shall obtain from each of its subcontractors an affidavit stating that the subcontractor does not employ, contract with, or subcontract with an Unauthorized Alien, as that term is defined in section 448.095(1)(k), Florida Statutes, as may be amended. HUB shall maintain a copy of any such affidavit from a subcontractor for, at a minimum, the duration of the subcontractor and any extension thereof. This provision shall not supersede any provision of this Agreement that requires a longer retention period.

Customer shall terminate this Agreement if it has a good faith belief that HUB has knowingly violated Section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes, as may be amended. If Customer has a good faith belief that HUB's subcontractor has knowingly violated section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes, as may be amended, Customer shall notify HUB to terminate its contract with the subcontractor and HUB shall immediately terminate its contract with the subcontractor. If Customer terminates this Agreement pursuant to the above, HUB shall be barred from being awarded a future contract by Customer for a period of one (1) year from the date on which this Agreement was terminated. In the event of such

termination, HUB shall also be liable for any additional costs incurred by Customer as a result of the termination.

15. Security.

- A. HUB hereby agrees to fully comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, regulations, orders, and directives regulating airport security and all security programs, policies and procedures established thereunder for PBI, as now or hereafter amended, including, but not limited to, 49 CFR 1542 and the Airport Security Program.
- B. HUB agrees to adhere to: (a) Customer's information/data security policies and procedures for all systems installed or maintained by HUB pursuant to the Agreement, regardless of location, that process, store, or transmit Customer or third party data or may provide access to Customer's information technology or operational technology systems; and (b) to employ information/data security controls in accordance with all applicable federal, state and local laws, regulations, orders, and directives, as now or hereafter amended. HUB shall provide Customer, upon request, with its PCI-DSS Attestation of Compliance (AOC) that validates that HUB meets the data privacy and information security procedures and protocols upon request, which shall be consistent with recognized industry standards and best practices (e.g., NIST Cybersecurity Framework), and provide initial and recurrent cybersecurity training for all persons that provide services to Customer pursuant to the Agreement to ensure that the security and confidentiality of Customer data and systems are protected. HUB will implement and comply with its data privacy and information security procedures and protocols. Upon Customer's request, HUB agrees to provide Customer with evidence, reasonably satisfactory to Customer, documenting its compliance with the requirements of this paragraph. HUB agrees to immediately notify Customer of all cybersecurity incidents, including, but not limited to, a compromised email account, unauthorized access to a database, or ransomware. In the event of a cybersecurity incident, HUB agrees to cooperate fully with Customer's response team in the event Customer data or systems are compromised and provide Customer with an after-action report summarizing the incident, including the incident's resolution and any insights gained.

16. Replacement of Schedule A- List 1. Schedule A - List 1, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced by the list of equipment set forth in the Exhibit 3, attached hereto and incorporated herein. The remainder of Schedule A shall remain unmodified.

17. Ratification of Agreement. Except as specifically modified herein, all of the terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unmodified and in full force and effect and are hereby ratified and confirmed by the parties hereto. In the event of a conflict between the terms and conditions of this Amendment and the Agreement, the terms and conditions of this Amendment shall prevail.

EXHIBIT 2 FEDERAL NONDISCRIMINATION PROVISIONS

A. Title VI Clauses for Compliance with Nondiscrimination Requirements. During the performance of this Agreement, HUB, for itself, its assignees, and successors in interest, agrees as follows:

1. **Compliance with Regulations:** HUB will comply with the Title VI List of Pertinent Nondiscrimination Acts and Authorities ("Nondiscrimination Acts and Authorities" as set forth in paragraph B below), as they may be amended from time to time, which are herein incorporated by reference and made a part of this Agreement.

2. **Nondiscrimination:** HUB, with regard to the work performed by it during this Agreement, will not discriminate on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in the selection and retention of subcontractors, including procurements of materials and leases of equipment. HUB will not participate directly or indirectly in the discrimination prohibited by the Nondiscrimination Acts and Authorities, including employment practices when this Agreement covers any activity, project, or program set forth in Appendix B of 49 CFR part 21.

3. **Solicitations for Subcontracts, including Procurements of Materials and Equipment:** In all solicitations, either by competitive bidding or negotiation made by HUB for work to be performed under a subcontract, including procurements of materials, or leases of equipment, each potential subcontractor or supplier will be notified by HUB of HUB's obligations under this Agreement and the Nondiscrimination Acts and Authorities on the grounds of race, color, or national origin.

4. **Information and Reports:** HUB will provide all information and reports required by the Acts, the Regulations, and directives issued pursuant thereto and will permit access to its books, records, accounts, other sources of information, and its facilities as may be determined by the sponsor or the Federal Aviation Administration to be pertinent to ascertain compliance with such Nondiscrimination Acts and Authorities and instructions. Where any information required of a contractor is in the exclusive possession of another who fails or refuses to furnish the information, HUB will so certify to the sponsor or the Federal Aviation Administration, as appropriate, and will set forth what efforts it has made to obtain the information.

5. **Sanctions for Noncompliance:** In the event of a contractor's noncompliance with the non-discrimination provisions of this Agreement, Customer will impose such contract sanctions as it or the Federal Aviation Administration may determine to be appropriate, including, but not limited to:

- a. Withholding payments to HUB under this Agreement until HUB complies; and/or
- b. Cancelling, terminating, or suspending a contract, in whole or in part.

6. **Incorporation of Provisions:** HUB will include the provisions of paragraphs one through six in every subcontract, including procurements of materials and leases of equipment, unless exempt by the Acts, the Regulations, and directives issued pursuant thereto. HUB will take action with respect to any subcontract or procurement as the sponsor or the Federal Aviation Administration may direct as a means of enforcing such provisions including sanctions for noncompliance. Provided, that if HUB becomes involved in, or is threatened with litigation by a subcontractor, or supplier because of such direction, HUB may request the sponsor to enter into any litigation to protect the interests of the sponsor. In addition, HUB may request the United States to enter into the litigation to protect the interests of the United States.

B. Title VI List of Pertinent Nondiscrimination Acts and Authorities. During the performance of this Agreement, HUB, for itself, its assignees, and successors in interest, agrees to comply with the following non-discrimination statutes and authorities, as may be amended, including but not limited to:

- Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (42 USC § 2000d et seq., 78 stat. 252) (prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin);
- 49 CFR part 21 (Non-discrimination in Federally-assisted programs of the Department of Transportation—Effectuation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964);
- The Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970, (42 USC § 4601) (prohibits unfair treatment of persons displaced or whose property has been acquired because of Federal or Federal-aid programs and projects);
- Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 USC § 794 et seq.), as amended (prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability); and 49 CFR part 27;
- The Age Discrimination Act of 1975, as amended (42 USC § 6101 et seq.) (prohibits discrimination on the basis of age);
- Airport and Airway Improvement Act of 1982 (49 USC § 471, Section 47123), as amended (prohibits discrimination based on race, creed, color, national origin, or sex);
- The Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987 (PL 100-209) (broadened the scope, coverage and applicability of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Age Discrimination Act of 1975 and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, by expanding the definition of the terms "programs or activities" to include all of the programs or activities of the Federal-aid recipients, sub-recipients and contractors, whether such programs or activities are Federally funded or not);
- Titles II and III of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, which prohibit discrimination on the basis of disability in the operation of public entities, public and private transportation systems, places of public accommodation, and certain testing entities (42 USC §§ 12131 – 12189) as implemented by U.S. Department of Transportation regulations at 49 CFR parts 37 and 38;

- The Federal Aviation Administration's Nondiscrimination statute (49 USC § 47123) (prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, and sex);
- Executive Order 12898, Federal Actions to Address Environmental Justice in Minority Populations and Low-Income Populations, which ensures nondiscrimination against minority populations by discouraging programs, policies, and activities with disproportionately high and adverse human health or environmental effects on minority and low-income populations;
- Executive Order 13166, Improving Access to Services for Persons with Limited English Proficiency, and resulting agency guidance, national origin discrimination includes discrimination because of limited English proficiency (LEP). To ensure compliance with Title VI, you must take reasonable steps to ensure that LEP persons have meaningful access to your programs (70 Fed. Reg. at 74087 to 74100);
- Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, as amended, which prohibits you from discriminating because of sex in education programs or activities (20 USC 1681 et seq).

C. Title VI Clauses for Construction/Use/Access to Real Property Acquired Under the Activity, Facility or Program.

1. HUB for itself and its successors in interest and assigns, as a part of the consideration hereof, does hereby covenant and agree as a covenant running with the land that (1) no person on the ground of race, color, or national origin, will be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination in the use of said facilities, (2) that in the construction of any improvements on, over, or under such land, and the furnishing of services thereon, no person on the ground of race, color, or national origin, will be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination, (3) that HUB will use the HUB Premises and any License Area in compliance with all other requirements imposed by or pursuant to the Nondiscrimination Acts And Authorities.
2. In the event of breach of any of the above nondiscrimination covenants, Customer will have the right to terminate this Agreement and to enter or re-enter and repossess the HUB Property and any License Area and the facilities thereon and hold the same as if this Agreement had never been made or issued.

D. Title VI Clauses for Transfer of Real Property Acquired or Improved Under the Activity, Facility, or Program.

HUB for itself and its successors in interest, and assigns, as a part of the consideration hereof, does hereby covenant and agree as a covenant running with the land that:

1. In the event facilities are constructed, maintained, or otherwise operated on the property described in this Agreement for a purpose for which a Federal Aviation Administration activity, facility, or program is extended or for another purpose involving the provision of similar services or benefits, HUB will maintain and operate such facilities and services in compliance with all requirements imposed by the Nondiscrimination Acts and Authorities (as may be amended) such that no person on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, will be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination in the use of said facilities.
2. In the event of breach of any of the above nondiscrimination covenants, Customer will have the right to terminate this Agreement and to enter, re-enter, and repossess said lands and facilities thereon, and hold the same as if this Agreement had never been made or issued.

E. Airport Concession Disadvantaged Business Enterprises ("ACDBE"). This Agreement may be subject to the requirements of the U.S. Department of Transportation's regulations, 49 CFR Part 23. It is the policy of Customer that ACDBEs shall have the maximum practicable opportunity to participate in the performance of contracts. HUB agrees that it will not discriminate against any business owner because of the owner's race, color, national origin or sex in connection with the award or performance of any concession Agreement, management contract, or subcontract, purchase or lease Agreement, or other Agreement covered by 49 CFR Part 23. HUB agrees to include the aforementioned statement in any subsequent concession Agreement or contract covered by 49 CFR Part 23, that it enters and cause those businesses to similarly include the statements in further Agreements.

F. General Civil Rights Provision. HUB agrees to comply with pertinent statutes, Executive Orders and such rules as are promulgated to ensure that no person shall, on the grounds of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability be excluded from participating in any activity conducted with or benefiting from Federal assistance. If HUB transfers its obligation to another, the transferee is obligated in the same manner as HUB. This provision obligates HUB for the period during which the property is owned, used or possessed by HUB and the Airport remains obligated to the Federal Aviation Administration. This provision is in addition to that required by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
