All operations were using runway 33 complete wit restraint and no limits imposed on anything and the public is abandoned to suffer the consequences as irresponsible operators INFORMATION REQUESTED: I would like to see where the over 6000 reports filed by our Association board members are locate directly to you and never received notification that reports sent to you would not be posted, processed, or acknowledged while Secondly, I would like to see where you are posting all comments, complaints, and reports your office receives so the public can that do appear, are a tiny percentage of the total and do not at all represent the extent or scope of the problem and a casual o helicopters.
