The Palm Beach County Department of Airports is committed to providing employees, tenants, passengers, and stakeholders at Palm Beach International Airport (PBI) the safest possible work and travel environment to minimize exposures to hazards and risks.

As part of the commitment, PBI is implementing a Safety Management System (SMS) that enables airport employees, tenants, passengers, and stakeholders to report safety-related concerns, incidents, and accidents to ensure they are proactively reviewed, addressed, mitigated, and resolved in a collaborative manner. The Department of Airports will implement the SMS in partnership with airlines, tenants, and other business partners.

PBI is dedicated to developing, implementing, maintaining, and constantly improving strategies and processes to ensure that all activities at PBI provide the highest level of safety and comply with local, State and Federal regulations and standards. PBI will provide the necessary policy direction, resources, and environment for a successful SMS. All levels of management and employees, beginning with the Director of Airports, are accountable for delivering the highest level of safety performance.

We commit to:

- Prioritizing safety as a core function in all activities;
- Promoting the identification and resolution of all safety-related issues;
- Collaborating with stakeholders to identify techniques to mitigate risks;
- Ensuring stakeholders receive safety information and training; and
- Considering new initiatives to improve safety.
