### BEACHES

Escambia County Beaches are **OPEN** which includes Pensacola Beach, Perdido Key and the Gulf Islands National Seashore. Beachgoers are asked to limit groups to 10 people or less and adhere to CDC social distancing measures.

### BARS

### RESTAURANTS

Restaurants in the state of Florida are **OPEN** at 50% capacity for indoor seating and full capacity for outdoor seating. Due to reduced operations, many businesses have adjusted hours and are offering to-go. You can search them here:

### MASKS & FACE COVERINGS

### TRI-STATE AREA TRAVELERS

Travelers coming to the state from New York, New Jersey and Connecticut must self-quarantine for 14 days after arrival. Vacation rentals are also not open to travelers from these states.

### TOLLS TO PENSACOLA BEACH

The \$1 toll on the Bob Sikes Bridge to Pensacola Beach is all-electronic. Travelers will be billed by TOLL-BY-PLATE to the address registered on the car if they do not have either a SunPass® or compatible transponder. TOLL-BY-PLATE customers will be charged a \$1 toll, plus a monthly \$2.50 administrative fee and will receive a bill by mail. If you are in a rental vehicle, rental agencies or their associated third-party vendors will assess the fees agreed to in your rental agreement to collect the toll(s).
