It's no wonder Perth is named a top destination by Time Out, Lonely Planet, Forbes, and CNN. Discover why Perth is Australia's rising star.

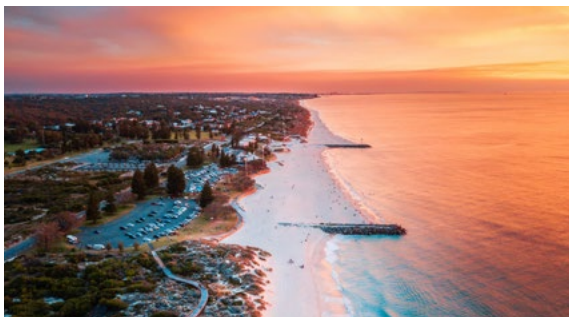


Northern Valleys

Just beyond Perth's northern fringe, the Northern Valleys landscape opens into a diverse tapestry of rolling pasture, bushland, sprawling olive groves and wind-swept dunes. Feel the thrill of sandboarding down the towering Lancelin Sand Dunes, then step back in time at New Norcia, Australia's only monastic town, where freshly baked bread is a local specialty. Follow the citrus-scented Chittering Valley Tourist Drive, tackle the trails at Bindoon Mountain Bike Park, and take in sweeping river-to-ocean views from the Moore River Estuary Lookout. After dark, marvel at the stars from the Gravity Discovery Centre and Observatory.

Sunset Coast | Waylo

Stretching along Perth's stunning Indian Ocean coastline, the Sunset Coast offers pristine beaches, vibrant waterfront precincts and unforgettable coastal experiences. Explore the stories and culture that shape the region, discover marine life at AQWA in Hillarys Boat Harbour. Walk or cycle scenic coastal trails, browse and dine at Karrinyup Shopping Centre, and enjoy Scarborough's lively Sunset Markets. Visit Yanchep National Park's Crystal Cave, join a whale-watching tour in season, savour sunset dining by the ocean, and unwind with a stay in beachfront or marina-side accommodation.



Swan Valley | Wurerup

With 195 years of winemaking heritage, the Swan Valley is Western Australia's oldest wine region, just 25 minutes from Perth. Explore world-class wineries, breweries, distilleries, and vibrant markets along the 32km Swan Valley Trail.

Indulge in local honey, chocolate, and wine, or savour fresh, regional produce at top eateries. Whether on a self-drive adventure or a private tour, discover why the Swan Valley is a true haven for food and wine lovers.



Rockingham | Mooriboordap

Located just 45 minutes south of Perth, Rockingham offers an abundance of outdoor activities along 37kms of beautiful coastline and expanses of safe beaches that make up the Shoalwater Islands Marine Park, Point Peron and Safety Bay.

Dive with dolphins, swim with sea lions and explore offshore islands where marine life thrives and coastal flora blooms. Take a walk along the foreshore strip for a smorgasbord of cafes and restaurants.



Rottnest Island | Wadjemup

Just 20km off Fremantle lies Wadjemup / Rottnest Island, a sun-drenched paradise of pristine beaches, dazzling marine life, breathtaking scenery and is home to the friendly quokka. Explore the island by bike, hop-on, hop-off bus or Segway, dive into crystal-clear waters to discover vibrant coral reefs and tropical fish, or unwind at beachfront dining venues serving fresh local seafood. With rich Aboriginal, military, and maritime history, Rottnest promises a truly unforgettable escape.



Perth Hills | Gaada-Moorn De Katamunda

Just 45 minutes from Perth, the Perth Hills are a natural haven of hiking trails, waterfalls, and vibrant villages like Mundaring and Kalamunda. Explore national parks, art galleries, and artisan markets, or discover the world-renowned Bibbulmun Track and Munda Biddi cycling trail. Home to the largest collection of endemic wildflowers in the world, the Perth Hills offer the perfect blend of nature, adventure, and relaxation year-round.



Avon Valley | Gogulgar

Discover the charm of the Avon Valley, where rolling countryside, historic townships and outdoor adventure await just an hour east of Perth. Explore the region by scenic self-drive or rail journey, soar above the landscape by hot air balloon, and uncover local history through museums, galleries and heritage attractions. Enjoy the Avon River year-round, from riverside picnics to white-water rafting and the iconic Avon Descent. Fremantle | Walyalup

Wander heritage neighbourhoods and streets lined with independent shops, small bars, stylish microbreweries and distilleries. Explore Fremantle Prison, a UNESCO World Heritage site, Fishing Boat Harbour and the iconic Fremantle Markets. Named Australia's top tourism town in 2025, Fremantle blends 19th century charm with modern flair, boutique hotels, award winning eateries, culture, arts and a vibrant live music scene.



Peel

Experience the majesty of towering old-growth forests and the tranquility of Murray River one hour drive southwest of Perth exploring the towns of Dwellingup, Pinjarra and Waroona, all a short drive inland from the coastal destination of Mandurah. Ride the world-renowned Munda Biddi Trail with Dwellingup Adventures or embark on the Hotham Valley for a train ride to Eymilyn Train Station returning via the famous Bibbulmun Track with Off the Beaten Track.



Mandurah | Mandjoogoordap

Just an hour south of Perth, Mandurah is a must-visit destination, home to the famous Giants by Thomas Dambo. Named Australia's Top Tourism Town for 2023 and ranked #3 for the 2025 Wotif Aussie Town of the Year, Mandurah offers stunning beaches, wildlife, and a laid-back, holiday vibe. Explore the Mandurah waterways by bike, hike, canoe or scenic cruise to spot wild dolphins and amazing bird life or visit Yalgorup National Park to see the ancient Thrombolite reef at Lake Clifton.

Rottnest Island | Easy island escape from Perth

Just a short ferry ride from Perth, Wadjemup / Rottnest Island offers pristine turquoise bays, friendly quokkas and relaxed island dining – all within easy reach of the main settlement. Whether visiting for the day or staying overnight, the island is an ideal escape for families and couples alike.

Family day trip adventure

Morning: Ease into island time

Start the day with a relaxed breakfast at Dome Café Rottnest Island, overlooking Thomson Bay. After breakfast, stop by the Rottnest Island General Store to stock up on snacks, sunscreen and any last-minute essentials.

Late morning: Discover the island highlights

See the best of the island without the effort on the Rottnest Island Bayseeker Tour with Quokka Coaches. This comfortable, air-conditioned bus tour winds through the island's most scenic locations, including Jeannie's Lookout, Wadjemup Lighthouse and picturesque coastal bays such as Mabel Cove.

Lunch: Relaxed dining with a view

Enjoy lunch at Sunsets Bar and Dining at The Lodge Wadjemup, overlooking Garden Lake. The menu features fresh Western Australian seafood and locally sourced produce, with share-style plates perfect for families.

Afternoon: Wildlife & sweet treats

Take a gentle walk around Garden Lake, one of the island's best spots to see the famous quokkas in their natural habitat. Cool off afterwards with a visit to Simmo's Ice Creamery, offering more than 60 flavours.

Before departure: Island shopping

Before catching the return ferry, browse the island's boutique stores. Island Gypsy Rottnest Island and Indianic Boutique Rottnest Island offer island-inspired clothing, gifts and souvenirs.

Rottnest Island | Easy island escape from Perth

Couples coastal escape (overnight itinerary)

Day 1 | Explore, indulge & unwind

Breakfast by the bay

Arrive on the island and enjoy a leisurely breakfast at Dome Café Rottnest Island, with panoramic views over Thomson Bay.

Experience Wadjemup Museum

Delve deeper into the history of the island with a walk through the Wadjemup Museum. Journey through the 17 exhibits and sculpture garden, where stories of Wadjemup's past invite quiet reflection. Leaving the museum, you're encouraged to carry this understanding with you as you continue to explore the island.

Cycle & play

Collect bikes from Pedal & Flipper Hire and cycle along the coastline past Bathurst Lighthouse. Stop for a friendly game of pickleball at Bathurst Tennis Courts with Rotto Rackets Sports.



Tapas by the sea

Pause for lunch at HAVZA, perched above the crystal-clear waters of The Basin. Enjoy Aegean-inspired tapas, refreshing drinks and time for a swim in one of the island's most iconic bays.

Sunset on the water

In the late afternoon, board a Rottnest Island Twilight Sail with Charter 1. Cruise along the coastline as the sun sets over the Indian Ocean, with views of Bathurst Lighthouse silhouetted against the sky.

Dinner by the beach

End the evening at Isola Bar e Cibo, where modern Italian share plates, cocktails and nighttime views across Thomson Bay create a relaxed yet romantic atmosphere.

Day 2 | Beaches, snorkelling & slow mornings

Morning beach prep

Pick up beach essentials from Rottnest Rentals and snorkelling equipment from Pedal & Flipper Hire.

Island exploration, together

Experience Wadjemup / Rottnest Island from a unique perspective on a 90-minute guided rickshaw tour with Rotto Rickshaws. Immersive audio storytelling brings the island's history and landscapes to life as you travel together.

Swim at Little Parakeet Bay

Continue along the coast to Little Parakeet Bay, a sheltered spot ideal for snorkelling and swimming in calm, clear waters.

Lunch before departure

Return towards the settlement and enjoy a final island meal at Lontara Rottnest Island, featuring share-style dishes inspired by Southeast Asian island flavours.



Island shopping

Browse island boutiques near the settlement before catching the ferry back to Perth, picking up keepsakes from Island Gypsy Rottnest Island or Indianic Boutique Rottnest Island.

Accommodation options

Day 1 | Discover another world

Arrive at Perth Airport, collect your rental vehicle and journey north-east to the charming Swan Valley, Western Australia's oldest wine region.

Make your first stop at the multi-award-winning Swan Valley Visitor Centre to gather local insights and hidden gems not found in the brochures.

A visit to Caversham Wildlife Park is a must for an authentic Australian wildlife experience. Enjoy koala and kangaroo encounters, and watch entertaining farm and whip-cracking demonstrations.

In the afternoon, check into your accommodation. The Swan Valley offers a range of excellent options, including The Vines Resort, ideal for families and golf enthusiasts, Swan Valley Hotel for comfort and convenience, or the beautifully appointed Mandoon Estate on the banks of the Swan River, offering a luxury stay alongside its renowned Homestead Brewery.

Unwind with a long, relaxed dinner overlooking vineyards as the sun sets.



Day 2 | Sample the flavours of the region

Start your day with breakfast at one of the Valley's many boutique cafés before heading to Sandalford Wines, one of the region's oldest and most prestigious wineries. Enjoy a guided tasting while learning about the history of the Swan Valley's heritage vines.

For lunch, stay on-site and indulge in a contemporary menu showcasing local produce.

In the afternoon, satisfy your sweet tooth along the Sweet Temptations Trail. Highlights include Whistler's Chocolate Company, Mondo Nougat, Margaret River Chocolate Company and House of Honey. These stops also make perfect places to pick up gourmet gifts.

Head to one of the local pubs in the evening for live music or local entertainment. Ask the visitor centre what's on this week.



Day 3 | Savour the Swan Valley

Begin your day in the historic village of Guildford, where heritage charm meets a vibrant café culture. Wander along James Street, browsing boutique stores and antique shops, before enjoying a leisurely breakfast in the hidden garden at Little Guildford.

For a uniquely Western Australian cultural experience, book a Bush Tucker Tasting and Talk with Dale Tilbrook. Gain insight into Noongar culture, traditional foods and storytelling in an intimate and enriching setting.

Continue your culinary journey with lunch at Pinelli Estate Winery, known for its authentic Italian cuisine and award-winning wines, enjoyed in a relaxed alfresco setting.

In the afternoon, visit Harvey Cheese to sample artisanal cheeses or assemble a gourmet platter to enjoy later. You are also invited to pick your own grapes at some vineyards. A delicious accompaniment to your platter.

As the day winds down, head to Bells Rapids. Take a gentle walk along the 2.5km river trail and soak in the expansive views as the sun sets over the Perth hinterland.

Day 4 | Get hands-on and indulge

Start your morning with a touch of indulgence at Maison Saint-Honoré, an authentic French patisserie renowned for its exquisite pastries and elegant high tea experience.

Balance the indulgence with a round at Supa Golf Swan Valley, a fun and relaxed version of golf suitable for all skill levels.

In the afternoon, escape with a late lunch at Bailey Brewing Co. Choose from woodfired pizzas or modern Australian fare.

To round off your Swan Valley experience, enjoy a hands-on experience at Giniversity, where you'll learn the art of gin-making and create your own bespoke 500ml bottle to take home.

Western Australia's capital reveals an extraordinary tapestry of parks and gardens that surprises and delights at every turn, from manicured heritage estates and wildflower-rich bushland to vibrant urban sanctuaries nestled between river and city skyline. Day 1 | City gardens

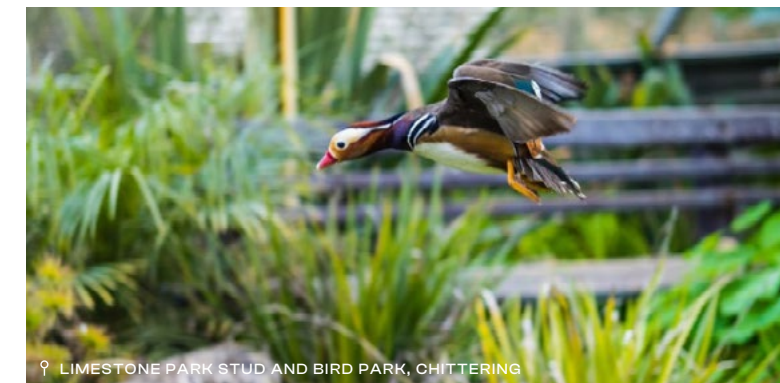

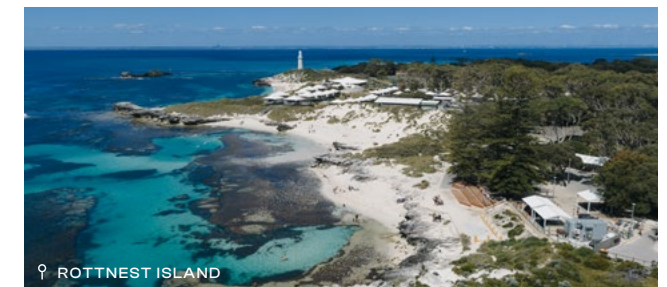
Day 5 | Coastal elegance in Fremantle

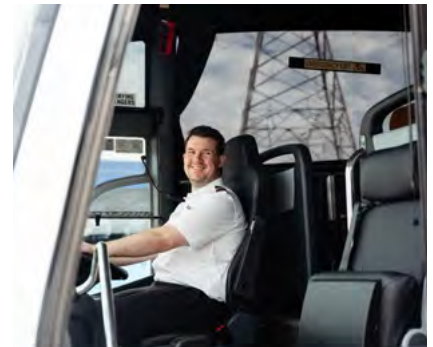

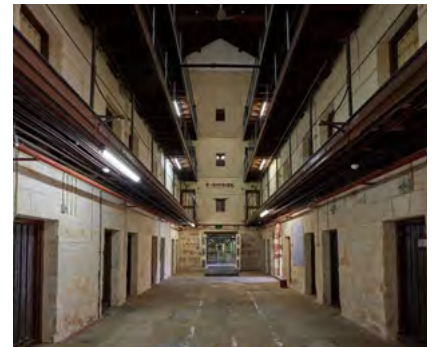

Fremantle Prison, Western Australia’s only World Heritage-listed building, offers a compelling heritage experience just minutes from Fremantle Train Station. 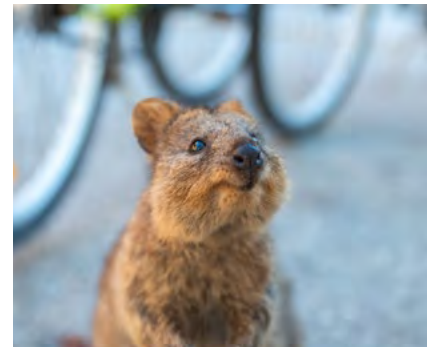

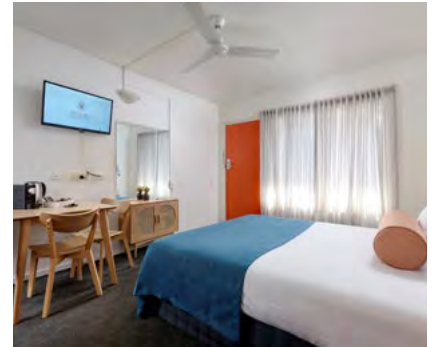
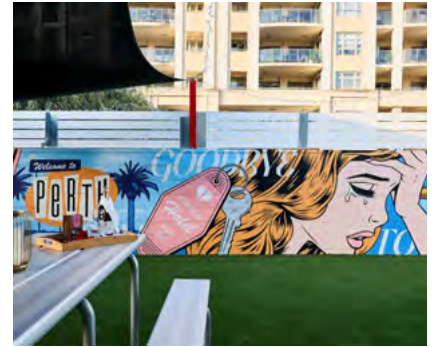

BY TRAIN

The Indian Pacific rail service, operated by Great Southern Rail, provides coast to coast transport over a three-day duration between Perth and Sydney, Melbourne or Adelaide. Trains arrive at East Perth Station which is 2.5km from Perth City.

BY SEA

Fremantle is the major arrival port for cruise ships to Western Australia and is a stop on international cruise itineraries as part of Australian coastal cruise packages.

A number of cruise lines call Fremantle their home port providing cruise itineraries which include Western Australia and South East Asia.

AIRPORT ACCESS

Perth Airport can be easily accessed by road and rail. Train services operate to and from Airport Central Station (Forrestfield–Airport line), and regular Transperth bus services also operate between Perth Airport and Perth City. A Perth Airport Terminal Transfer Bus transfers passengers between T1/T2 and T3/T4 for free, as the terminals are located on opposite sides of the airport estate. Car hire is available from Perth Airport and there are dedicated areas for rideshare and passenger pick-up and drop-off by private transport.

GETTING AROUND

TAXIS AND RIDESHARE

Taxis are usually plentiful in Perth and are available at dedicated ranks available throughout the CBD, major shopping hubs and nightspots and from both the domestic and international airport terminals.

BUSES

An extensive bus network provides a main public transport option for Perth. The Perth City Underground Bus Port, located in the heart of the Perth City Link, is the central hub for bus transport throughout the Perth Metropolitan area.

FREE CAT BUS

Perth is serviced by the free Central Area Transit service or CAT. The CAT buses run on four routes providing free transport around the city centre and to Leederville. A free SURF CAT connects Stirling Train Station with Scarborough Beach on the Sunset Coast.

FERRIES

The main ferry terminal is located at Barrack Street Jetty in the CBD. The jetty services travel to and from Fremantle and Rottnest Island and is the departure point for wine cruises to the Swan Valley. Transperth also operates a ferry service between Elizabeth Quay and Mends Street in South Perth enabling easy access to Perth Zoo.

TRAINS

Perth Central Train Station, including Perth Underground Station, is located in the heart of the city. Modern trains link Perth's suburbs at Claremont, Subiaco, Fremantle, Butler, Mandurah, Midland, Armadale as well as Perth Airport.

PRIVATE VEHICLES, COACHES AND CAR HIRE

There are several private car and coach companies operating with both small and large vehicles in the city and surrounds. These services are perfect for transfer to and from the airport, transfer to events or for local and regional tours. Ola and Uber are readily available.

WALKING AND CYCLING

Perth has a comprehensive network of cycle and dual-use paths in the central city and beyond. One of the most popular routes for leisure cyclists and walkers is a circuit around the Swan River at the doorstep of the city. Riverside routes are clearly signposted and detailed cycle maps can be obtained online at destinationperth.com.au. There are also pathways popular for recreation lining much of the coast.

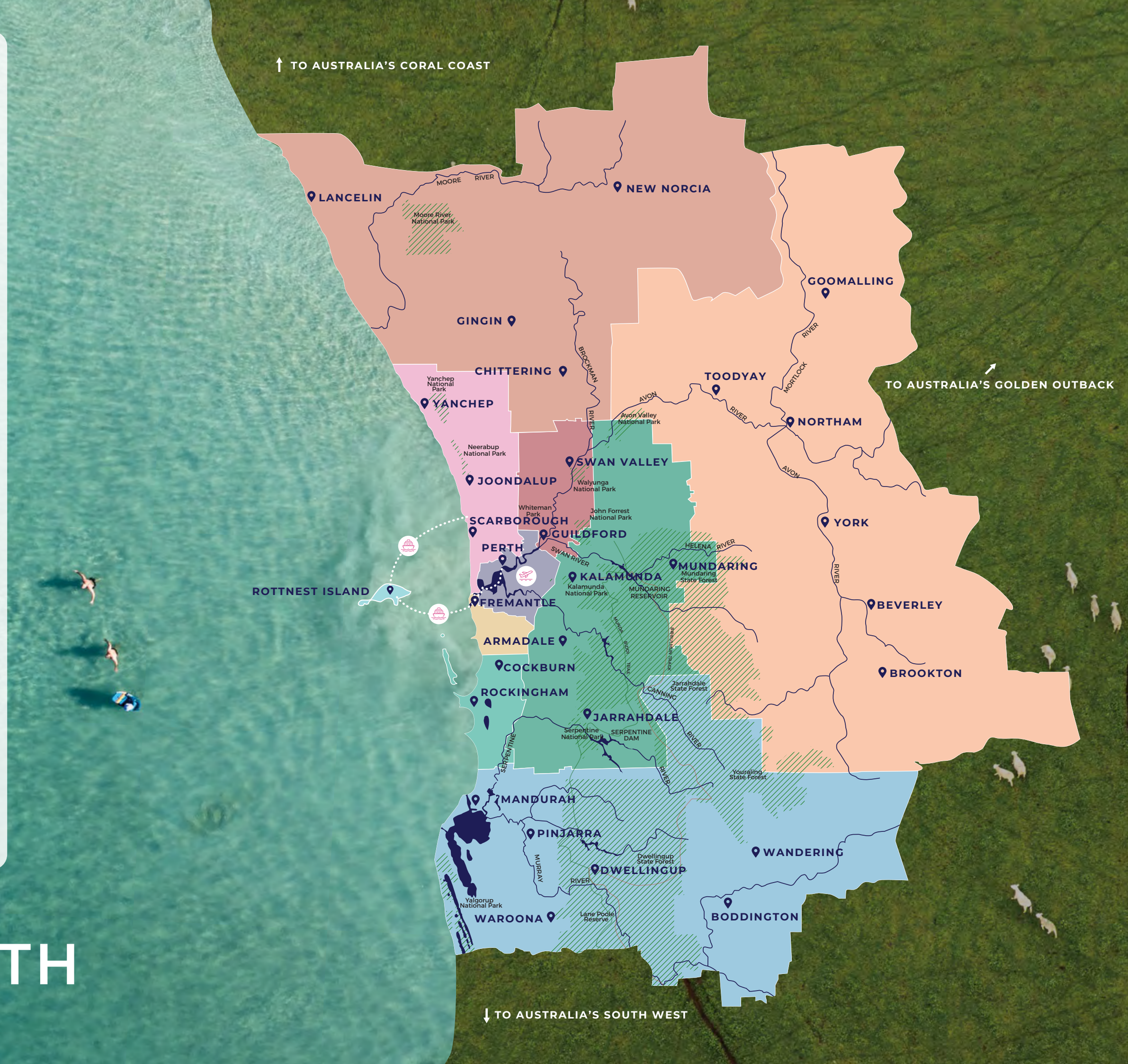
