From 1994 to 2004, Giuliano served as Mayor of Tempe, becoming the youngest person elected to the role. Under his leadership, Tempe received the prestigious All-America City Award. He is also a published author and dedicated community advocate, having earned numerous accolades for his work in public policy, civic engagement, and business leadership.
