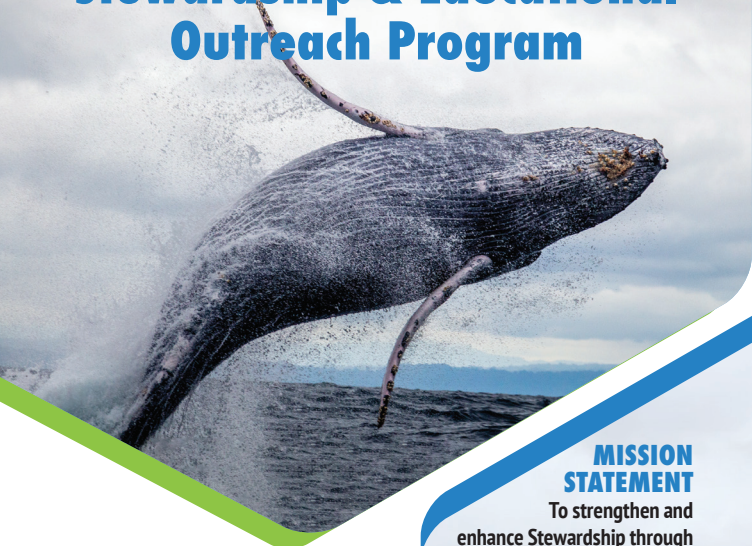


Join the Pismo Beach Stewardship & Educational Outreach Program
