- Stay on the trail to avoid disturbing nests, dens, and native plants.

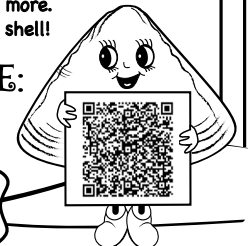
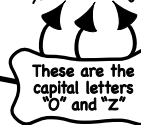
### Bring the Preserve to life by finding and then coloring in the Woodland creatures listed below.
