

Experience the laid-back charm and natural beauty of Pompano Beach.

DID YOU KNOW?

Pompano Beach is named after the Florida pompano, a prized game fish found off the City's coast, renowned for its delicious flavor and popular among fishermen and seafood enthusiasts. The Fisher Family Pier's design mimics the shape of a pompano's head, and throughout the City, you'll find 5-foot-tall painted pompano statues, part of Pompano Beach's first major public art installation.

WEATHER:

Pompano Beach enjoys a year-round, tropical climate. Winters are typically warm and dry with low humidity. Summer travelers experience more intense temperatures, sultry air and a higher chance of intermittent rain.

EXPLORE THE BEACH

Pompano Beach is more vibrant, welcoming, and beautiful than ever. Bask in the sunshine along 3 miles of expansive sandy shoreline and enjoy the tree-lined promenade, where you might catch a live concert on the great lawn or see kids having fun at the interactive splash pad. Stay active with outdoor gym equipment, relax under a gazebo with a picnic, or grab a bite from nearby eateries.

A short walk along the promenade leads to the iconic, 900-foot Fisher Family Pier, ideal for strolling, fishing, or watching the pelicans. Fishing rods and bait are available at the Bait Shack located at the pier's entrance.

The pier anchors the Pompano Beach Fishing Village, where you'll find ample parking, a variety of dining options, a tiki bar, a cozy coffee hub, and other shops. Be sure to stop by the Visitor Center at the southwest corner of the Beach Garage for recommendations, information, and discount coupons.

DIVING

The warm waters of the Gulf Stream keep the ocean at a comfortable temperature year-round, creating an ideal setting for snorkelers and divers. Explore vibrant natural reefs teeming with marine life, or discover the 18 shipwrecks of Shipwreck Park, resting beneath the waves. Dive sites are easily accessible, with many just a short boat ride from shore.

FISHING

A city named after a fish is bound to embrace the salt life and Pompano Beach certainly does. Known for some of the world's best sport fishing, its unique topography and warm Atlantic waters provide an ideal habitat for prized fish like mahi-mahi, wahoo, tuna, and more. Daily fishing charters offer both reef and deep-sea fishing, catering to anglers of all experience levels.

WATER ADVENTURES

The crystal-clear waters of Pompano Beach offer perfect conditions for any watersport, whether in the ocean or the Intracoastal waterways. Local vendors are ready to equip you for your next adventure, whether it's kayaking, standup paddleboarding, jet skiing, sailing, or kiteboarding.

GOLF

Pompano Beach is home to two premier 18-hole golf venues as well as the premier entertainment destination, Topgolf.

The Pompano Beach Golf Club offers two courses, including the newly redesigned Pines Course. Palm-Aire Country Club features three 18-hole courses. Both courses are open to the public.

Sgt. Kip Jacoby Park offers an all-accessible playground, providing children of all abilities the opportunity to play alongside their peers.

ENTERTAINMENT

Pompano Beach offers an abundance of entertainment, with a diverse lineup of shows and concerts at the city's five cultural arts venues, including a 3,000-seat covered amphitheater. Local restaurants, bars, and hotels regularly feature live bands and entertainers, showcasing a wide variety of musical styles.

GAMING

Harrah's Pompano Beach features a smoke-free main casino with over 1,200 slot machines and electronic table games, a WSOP Poker Room with 40+ live-action poker tables, a high-tech sports bar with a wagering and simulcast area, and an open-air gaming terrace. It also boasts a 14-seat video poker bar and more than 30 TVs broadcasting news, sports, and racing. The casino offers two exceptional restaurants: a casual spot serving NY-style deli favorites and a classic American steakhouse.

FESTIVALS

Immerse yourself in world-class jazz, and explore nautical markets that celebrate Pompano Beach's water-loving lifestyle. Enjoy vibrant cultural festivals showcasing everything from the Caribbean islands to distant India. CULTURAL ARTS

Pompano Beach is a dynamic cultural hub. Our city offers a rich tapestry of artistic experiences, including worldclass venues, galleries, live music, and public art, for art lovers of all kinds. The Pompano Beach Cultural Center includes a 300-seat theatre which can convert to a cabaret style venue with table tops and chairs. The gallery at the Center has achieved acclaim for its curatorial showcasing of regional, national and international artists.

The Pompano Beach Amphitheatre (Amp) is a 3,000-seat outdoor venue that offers an amazing concert experience with one epic act after another. The "Amp" is known for hosting a wide variety of concerts ranging from hard rock, country, soul, rap and everything in between. Ali Cultural Arts Center is a unique venue offering public visual art exhibits, musical and dance performances, providing a glimpse into the heritage of the Pompano Beach African-American community, and has become a center for the arts and history of Pompano Beach.

Bailey Contemporary Arts Center (BaCA) is a beautiful contemporary art gallery. On the second floor there are working studio spaces for BaCA's resident artists, who range from collagists to potters, painters to sculptors. Patrons can venture upstairs to watch them create. The center area provides a lounge space for brainstorming or small meetings. It is the second oldest historical building in Pompano Beach.


Many hotels also offer special packages tied to local events, festivals, and performances.

PLACES OF INTEREST

Sample-McDougald House is a historic 4,700-square-foot home built in 1916. Originally located on Dixie Highway, it was relocated to 450 Northeast 10th Street by the Sample-McDougald House Preservation Society. Added to the U.S. National Register of Historic Places in 2004, the house is open to the public. For more information, visit samplemcdougald.org.

Pompano Beach Air Park offers various services, including flight training, aircraft rentals, air taxi/charter, scenic tours, and aerial photography. The popular jogging/walking path around the air park's perimeter is a favorite for both residents and visitors.

Goodyear Blimp, one of only three, the Wingfoot Two is based in Pompano Beach. The general public is welcome to visit the base, though rides are by invitation only, tours of the base are available when the Blimp is in town. Visit goodyearblimp.com for more information.

The Historical Society keeps Pompano Beach's history alive with its monthly, 2-hour narrated bus tour of the city's most historic sites, including recently revitalized landmarks. Private tours of the historic Kester Cottages Museum are also available by appointment.

Situated between Brightline's Boca Raton and Fort Lauderdale stations, Pompano Beach is easily accessible by high-speed rail from both Miami and Orlando.

Pompano Beach is designated as Autism-Friendly, ensuring an inclusive experience for all.

Pompano Beach provides access mats at all six beach entrances and offers complimentary beach wheelchairs seven days a week, available on a first-come, firstserved basis.

Additionally, the Pompano Beach Golf Course proudly offers the Solo Rider Adaptive Golf Cart, available for rent to enhance accessibility on the course.
