IT'S EASY TO VISIT POMPANO BEACH!



Accessible by three international airports, with Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport just 30-minutes away. Private planes may travel through Pompano Beach's own Air Park.



Easily accessed by car via I-95 or Florida's Turnpike.



The Tri-Rail Train stops at Pompano Beach Station. Situated between Brightline's Boca Raton and Fort Lauderdale stations, Pompano Beach is easily accessible by high-speed rail from both Miami and Orlando.



Once here, utilize the Circuit, a free, on-demand, City-sponsored micro-transit option, to explore the coastal area. Service may be ordered via the Circuit app.

Beach: Pompano Beach is located on Florida's Gold Coast with three miles of scenic shoreline. The Fishing Village features walkable entertainment, shopping and dining options.

Water Adventures: Enjoy surfing, kite boarding, jet skiing, sailing, kayaking, paddle boarding and more.

Jellyfish Museum: Step into glowing exhibits and immersive displays showcasing the beauty and mystery of these mesmerizing creatures.

Fishing: The world's best sport fishing can be enjoyed by anglers off our shore, the Fisher Family Pier and the Hillsboro Inlet. Charter boat rentals and fishing excursions are offered daily.

SCUBA Diving & Snorkeling: Pompano Beach is the "Wreck Capital" of Florida! There are miles of natural reefs to explore, plus 18 wrecks off our shore, known as Shipwreck Park. Snorkel at Wahoo Bay, our one-of-a-kind marine conservation area.

The Amp: The Pompano Beach Amphitheater is a 3000-seat, covered venue that presents major concert performances. Its surrounding park grounds can accommodate festivals for up to 7000 visitors.

Golfing: Pompano Beach is home to five, 18-hole golf courses, including the Pompano Beach Golf Club, featuring the newly redesigned Pines course. Topgolf offers climate-controlled outdoor hitting bays, a full-service restaurant, multiple bars, an outdoor patio, rooftop terrace, music, and family-friendly events.

Gaming: Harrah's Casino features Florida's only open-air gaming terrace, over 1,200 slots and electronic table games, simulcast racing, special events plus casual and fine dining.

Water Taxi: The Pompano Beach Water Taxi has 12 stops, allowing passengers to easily explore local attractions, dining, shopping, and more, with connectivity to Fort Lauderdale.
