## Your Safety is Important

The safety of guests, volunteers, and vendors is our top priority. Due to COVID-19, we will have enhanced health and safety guidelines for Port A Live Music Fest. Port A Live Music Fest organizers are in regular communication with local health and public safety officials and will follow current recommendations and guidelines in place at the time of the event.

## COVID-19 Warning

- An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place regardless of precautions that may be taken.
- COVID-19 is an extremely contagious virus that can lead to severe illness and death.
- According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and guests with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable.
- By attending Port A Live Music Fest, you voluntarily assume all risks, hazards, and dangers related to exposure to COVID-19.

## What to Expect at Port A Live Music Fest

### Social Distancing

- **Keep Your Distance**—Keep a minimum of at least six feet of distance between you and others not in your party.

### Masks

- Face coverings are not required at Port A Live Music Fest; however, we encourage guests who are not fully vaccinated for COVID-19 to wear a mask.
- Please be advised that live music venues are independent small businesses and may set their own guidelines and requirements for entering their establishments.

### Hand Sanitizing Stations

- Hand sanitizers will be available at the Landshark concert. Live music venues might or might not have sanitizers so please come prepared.
- Please use sanitizers frequently.

## What We Ask of Our Guests

### People With Underlying Medical Conditions

- Please note the CDC advises that older adults and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions might be at higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19.

- Guests should evaluate their risk in determining whether to attend.
- People who show no symptoms can spread COVID-19 if they are infected. Any interaction with the general public poses an elevated risk of being exposed to COVID-19, and Port A Live Music Fest cannot guarantee that you will not be exposed during your visit

## Stay at Home

- Stay at home if you are sick or running a temperature, or are having any sign or symptoms of illness, loss of taste or smell, etc.
