







EXPLORE THE INDIANA DUNES NATIONAL & STATE PARKS

Indiana Dunes is made up of both a National Park and a State Park, and each park has its own fee.

On March 31, 2022, the National Park Service implemented an entrance fee for the Indiana Dunes National Park. National Park passes can be purchased at the Indiana Dunes Visitor Center, Paul H. Douglas Center, West Beach gatehouse (seasonally), and online (<u>recreation.gov</u>).

Separate passes are needed for the Indiana Dunes State Park and can be purchased at the Indiana Dunes State Park gatehouse. For discounts and special passes, check online.

MORE ON THE NATIONAL PARK

Chosen as one of the "Top 10 Urban Escapes" by National Geographic, the 61st National Park is a series of sites along the southern shore of Lake Michigan, which includes 15 miles of beaches, more than 50 miles of trails, dunes, bogs, historic sites, camping, and more. Try the **Diana of the Dunes Dare and Dune Succession Trail** at West Beach. Just watch for the brown signs along Highway 12.

PETS

Pets are allowed on all beaches except for the lifeguarded area of West Beach. Pets are allowed on all trails except for Glenwood Dunes and Pinhook Bog. Pets are also allowed at the campground. Pets must be on a leash at all times.

On February 15, 2019, Indiana was given its first national park! After 53 years as the Indiana Dunes National Lakeshore, this area was renamed the Indiana Dunes National Park. It's no surprise considering the park sees nearly as many visitors a year as Mount Rushmore. Also, the park's biodiversity ranks fifth out of all 400-plus National Park Service protected lands. With over a thousand native plant species and 370 bird species, it is one of the most biodiverse areas in the U.S.



Dare to Be Different? Embrace the Dunes.

In honor of the daring and free spirit of Alice Mabel Gray, also known as Diana, a nearby sand hill has been named "Diana's Dune." You can now hike in a local legend's footsteps at Indiana Dunes National Park's West Beach. Explore the natural wonders of her beloved Dunes terrain while learning about dune development.

GET STARTED

The Diana of the Dunes Dare is a self-guided trail at Indiana Dunes National Park's West Beach, 376 N. County Line Rd., Gary 46403. The trail is marked, and you can take the dare any day of the year.

Dune Succession

Follow the trail to learn about the four stages of dune development. This scenic, but strenuous, trail includes a climb up quite a few stairs (can you count them all?) for a spectacular view of Lake Michigan.

After you beat the dare, buy a Diana of the Dunes Dare shirt or hoodie and pick up a free sticker from the Indiana Dunes Visitor Center, 1215 N. State Rd. 49, Porter, IN 46304.



MORE ON THE STATE PARK

A state park surrounded by a national park, the Indiana Dunes State Park is 2,182 acres of dunes, marshes, swamps, hardwood forests, white pine groves, and a lifeguarded beach (summer only). The park has 16.5 miles of trails, including



The 3 Dune Challenge and Trail 9—named the best place to hike in Indiana by *USA Today*—and offers camping, picnicking, and showers, as well as a dining venue, camp store, and park naturalist at their Nature Center.

GRILLING

Grills are allowed on the concrete near the beach, in picnic areas, and in the west lot. Charcoal grills are provided in the picnic areas and shelters. Grilling is not permitted on the beach.



PETS

Beaches east of the lifeguarded swimming areas and all trails are designated for pets. Pets must be on a leash at all times.



PROGRAMS

BIRDING

Cowles Bog Trail

Considered a globally significant Important Bird Area (IBA), this site supports several nesting wetland birds that are species of conservation concern in Indiana, including American Bittern, Sandhill Crane, Little Blue Heron, Black-crowned Night Heron, Virginia Rail, American Black Duck, and a large population of Marsh Wren. 1450 N. Indiana Dunes State Park

The park attracts breeding birds more commonly found farther south (including WatchList species Prairie Warbler and Louisiana Waterthrush), as well as more northerly species (Canada and Blackburnian Warblers). Migration sightings include such WatchList species as Kirtland's, Golden-winged, and Bay-breasted Warblers. The west lot observation area is known for several state record species counts. Wading birds like herons and egrets, and songbirds, such as warblers and red-winged blackbirds, are again abundant. During migration periods, see flocks of ducks and geese. Westchester Migratory Bird Sanctuary



FISHING

Kankakee River Water Trail

Farthest south in the region lies the Kankakee River, also known as the Everglades of the North, where northern pike, catfish, walleye, bass, and bluegill are common. The Kankakee River was once a vital link between French Canada and the Mississippi River. Relatively straight and easy paddling makes this waterway a place to enjoy the rural area surrounding the river. Lake Michigan Water Trail

With 43 miles of shoreline in Indiana, Lake Michigan is a fishing adventure waiting to happen. The most common catches include coho and chinook salmon, steelhead, lake trout, yellow perch, and smallmouth. Experienced kayakers with a sea kayak can paddle more than 75 miles of coastline. 



The Spa Restaurant was originally opened by Harry Leroy Day in 1933 and over the course of the next couple centuries it had quite a reputation for being one of the best restaurants of its time in the Porter area. Unfortunately the Spa changed hands in ownership a few times and eventually sat vacant for a number of years.

Around 2018 a family invested in the Springhouse Inn and purchased the building. In 2021, the Spa building was purchased by the same family. Almost a century later, we are ready to keep

the Spa legacy going. In the utmost respect to the original restaurant, we will continue to serve dinner for the first time in about two decades. Musicians will continue to fill the room with live entertainment every weekend. Great drinks will be poured. Laughs and conversations will continue in the walls that we wish could speak. Best of all, the history lives on.
