Item No. 450–Container, cargo, and equipment staging.

Issue No. 10

Effective Date: October 1, 2020

Containers, cargo, chassis, and equipment, including cargo handling equipment can only be staged on dock aprons and common use, nonleased, nonassigned areas with the prior approval of the Port Everglades Department, Operations Division. All requests must be made in a timely manner, but not less than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the time the staging area is needed by the Port user. If a request is approved, it will be for a period not to exceed seven (7) calendar days. Use of a staging area without prior permission, or beyond the approved period, will result in the imposition of a use penalty in the amount of seventy-two dollars and ten cents (\$72.10) for each calendar day or any portion thereof for each container, chassis, and piece of cargo or equipment located on a staging area.
