Fort Nelson

Discover the national collection of artillery Fort Nelson - a restored Victorian fortress overlooking Portsmouth. Explore the ramparts, tour the tunnels and see artillery from across the world - including a 15th-century Turkish bombard cannon, a gigantic 200-tonne railway howitzer, and the infamous 'Big Babylon' Iraqi supergun. An on-site café also offers an ideal place to stop for a bite to eat.

HMS Warrior in Portsmouth Historic Dockyard is the next stop on this Victorian voyage of discovery. The fastest, largest and most powerful warship in the world when she was launched, join Warrior's Captain and crew on board and explore this almighty Victorian battleship for yourself.
