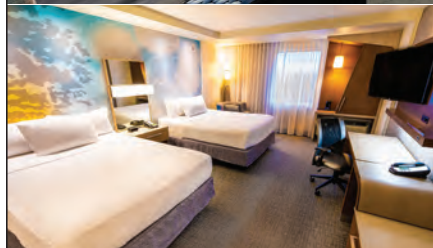

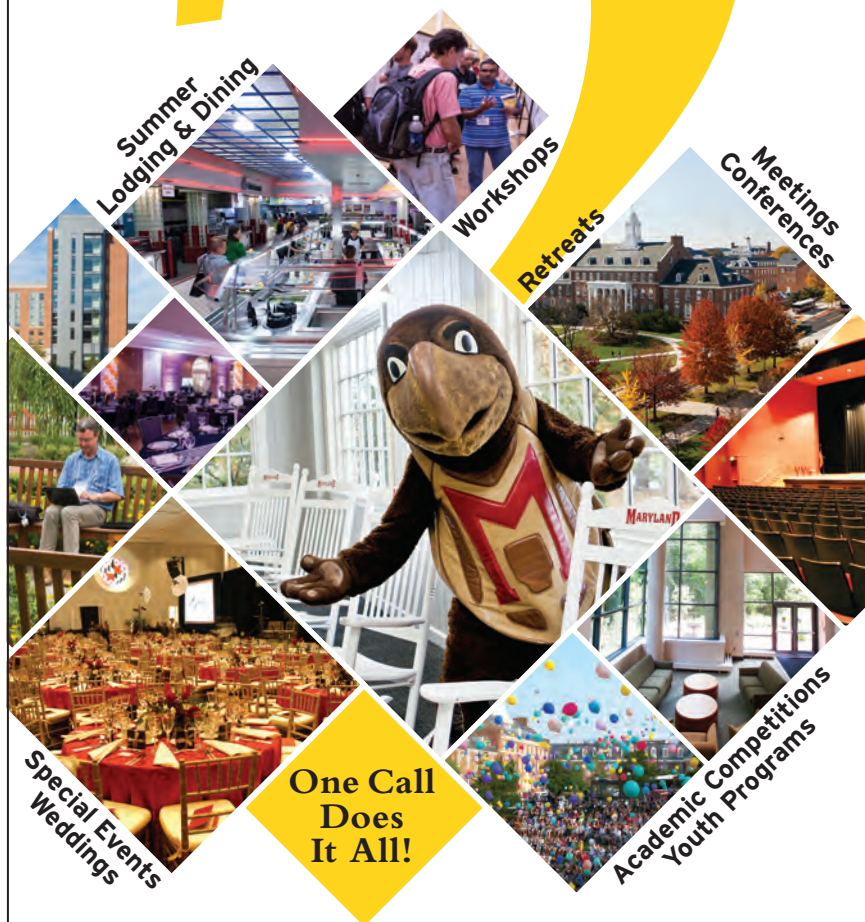

America's First Greentown: Greenbelt is a planned community that was designed and built by the federal government during the Great Depression of the 1930s. Greenbelt was the first of three federal New Deal “greentowns” — with one in Wisconsin and Ohio. In 1997, Greenbelt became a National Historic Landmark.

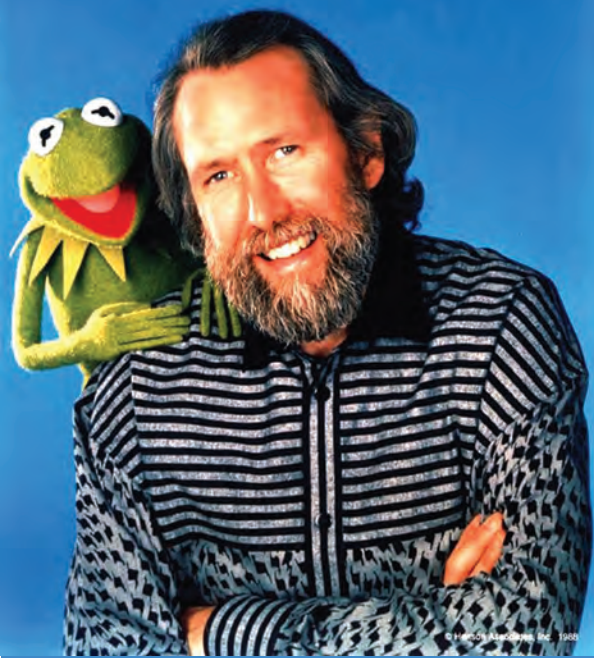

WHERE ARE WE?

In the summer of 1608, during an exploratory journey down the historic Potomac River, Captain John Smith became the first European to record a visit to the area that we now know as fabulous **Prince George's County**. Soon, small groups of settlers began populating the area that was rich in land and resources.

HOW DID WE GET HERE?

When the first settlers arrived, the area was inhabited by the Piscataway Indian Nation – the first people of Prince George's. Piscataway villages ranged from the Anacostia River and eastward to the Patuxent River. Three branches of the Piscataway tribe still exist today, with two still based in Prince George's. The **American Indian Village at Patuxent River Park** replicates an Eastern Woodland Village with various components providing visitors the opportunity to explore the history of the Indigenous peoples of Prince George's County, Maryland, and the surrounding areas.

LET'S SETTLE THIS

The first Maryland colonist arrived in 1634. A wise English trader suggested to Governor Leonard Calvert that he seek permission from the Piscataways before establishing a permanent settlement. Heeding the advice, Calvert met with tribal leaders on Piscataway Creek and gained their permission. The new settlement was eventually named St. Mary's City and its subsequent development opened the door to other local settlements in Prince George's.

A COUNTY IS BORN

On April 23, 1696, St. George's Day, a new county containing segments of Charles and Calvert counties was established by the English Council of Maryland. It would be named after **Prince George of Denmark**, husband of England's Queen Anne.

HISTORICALLY SPEAKING

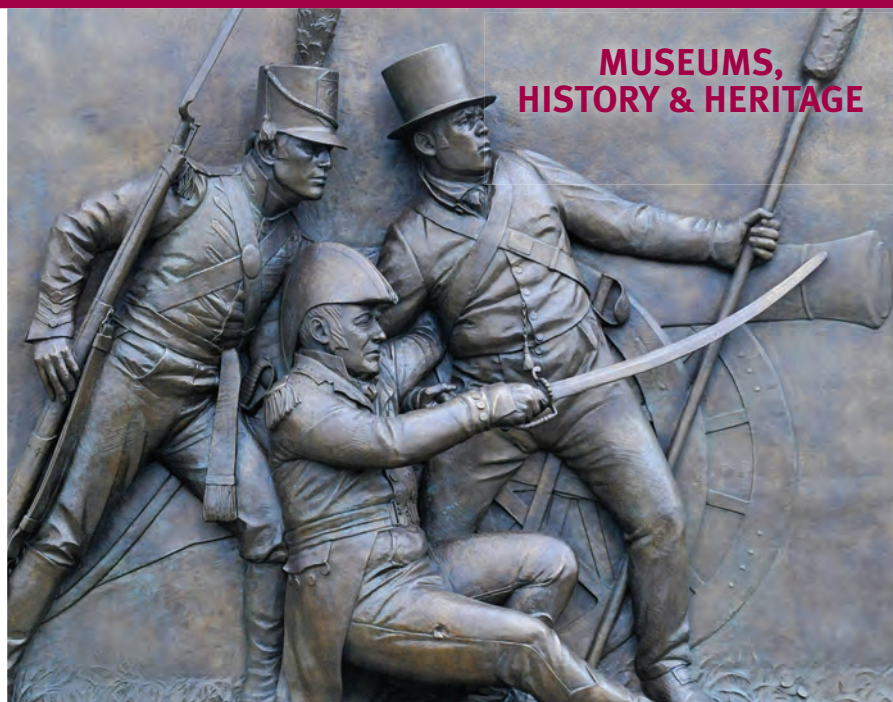
Today, Prince George's County is home to almost a million residents, is an economic engine for the state of Maryland, and is one of the most-visited destinations in the state. Yet, it still retains a wealth of history and heritage, home to over 325 historic sites and eleven **National Register Historic Districts**.

BUCKLE UP FOR HISTORY

Take a ride through the historic districts of Prince George's. Journey through the **Anacostia Trails Heritage Area**, the **Broad Creek** and **Greenbelt** Historic Districts. Explore Old Town Greenbelt, a historic planned community, one of the four "green towns" created during President Roosevelt's New Deal Era. See historic sites such as **Riversdale**, **Surratt House**, **Darnall's Chance**, **Belair Mansion & Stable Museum**, **Montpelier Mansion**, **Laurel Museum**, the **College Park Aviation Museum**, and many more. Or, take a picture at the **Battle of Bladensburg Memorial**.

Learn about 18th century life on a tobacco plantation at the **National Colonial Farm** at Piscataway Park or the **Rural Life Museums** at Patuxent River Park. Visit **Fort Washington Park** to see remnants of the fort built to defend the river approach to Washington, DC from the War of 1812 through World War II.

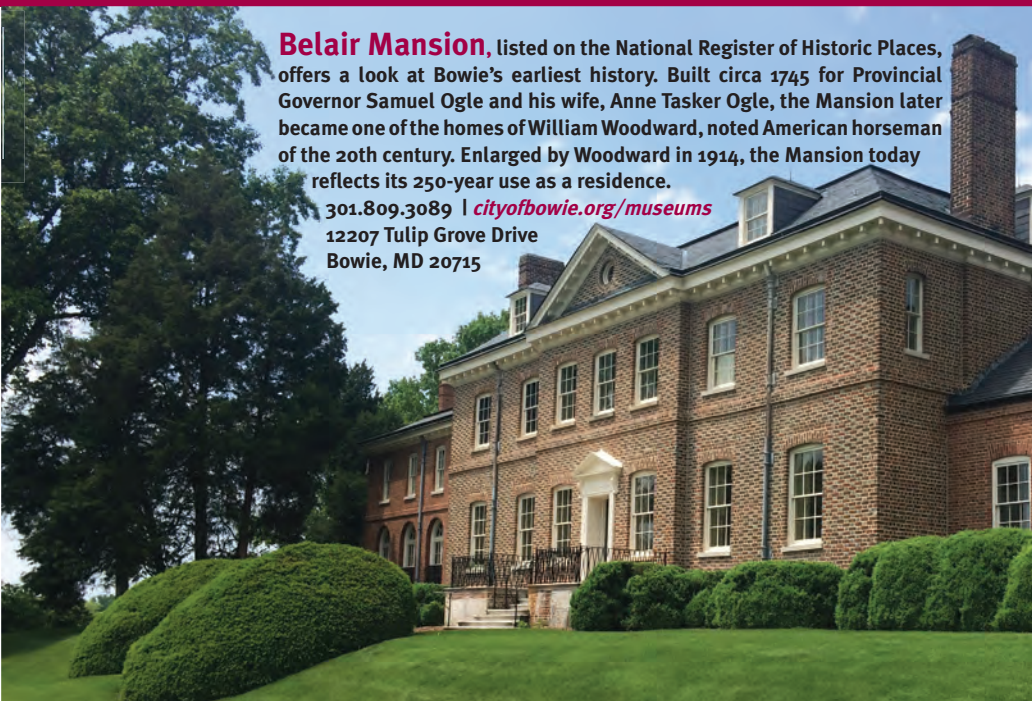

Belair Stable Museum

The Stable, built in 1907 by William Woodward, was part of the 20th century's famous "Belair Stud Stable," one of the country's premier stables from the 1920's through the 1950's. Belair was home to Gallant Fox (1930) and Omaha (1935) – the only father/son horses to capture Thoroughbred racing's famous Triple Crown Series. In 1955, Belair's Nashua, an incomparable champion, was Horse of the Year. Other champions, including Johnstown, Fighting Fox, and Vagrancy also called Belair home.

Billingsley Point & The Billingsley House Museum

Located on 430 acres of land overlooking the confluence of the Patuxent River and the Western Branch, Billingsley is an early plantation home of the Tidewater Colonial style. Built around 1740 as a home for the Weems family, the house is named for Maj. John Billingsley, who obtained the original land grant from the second Lord Baltimore in 1662.

Bowie Railroad Museum

Plans for a railroad from Baltimore into Southern Maryland began to develop after the Civil War. In 1872, the Baltimore and Potomac Railroad (later integrated into the Pennsylvania Railroad System) opened the Bowie Station. Developer Ben M. Plumb seized that opportunity and developed "Huntington City" around that railroad station. Shops, hotels, and comfortable Victorian houses filled the tree-lined streets of Huntington City, renamed "Bowie" in 1880 to honor Governor Oden Bowie. The station remained a busy stop until 1989, when it closed to make way for a new station at Bowie State University.

The College Park Aviation Museum, an affiliate of the Smithsonian Institution, is located on the grounds of the world's oldest continuously operating airport. The airport, listed on the National Register of Historic Places, was founded in 1909 when Wilbur Wright came here to give flight instruction to the first military aviators. Visitors to the museum step into an open one-and-a-half-story exhibit space, which highlights the display of unique aircraft and artifacts and tells the story of the airport's many aviation firsts.

The Columbia Air Center Outdoor Exhibit Area interprets the aviation history of an airfield that long ago disappeared but has not been forgotten. In 1941, aviation history was made when the first African American-owned and operated airfield in the state of Maryland was licensed on the site at the end of Croom Airport Road. John W. Greene Jr., a pioneer in black aviation, was instrumental in developing the airfield, which was originally called Riverside Field.

Darnall's Chance House Museum

Darnall's Chance was built between 1741-1742 for James Wardrop, a Scottish immigrant, who amassed a fortune as a merchant and entrepreneur in the bustling port-town of Upper Marlborough, Maryland. In 1748, he married Lettice Lee, daughter of Phillip Lee, the progenitor of the Maryland branch of the illustrious Lee family of Virginia.

Dinosaur Park

Did you know the official State Dinosaur was first discovered in Prince George's County? Walk the same grounds the dinosaurs did millions of years ago; discover secrets of Maryland's prehistoric past. The park is a unique site in Laurel, Maryland, which preserves a rare deposit of fossils from the early Cretaceous period, about 115 million years ago. From the bones and teeth of the Maryland State Dinosaur *Astrodon Johnstoni* to the remains of early flowering plants, the fossils found at Dinosaur Park help scientists reconstruct our region's ancient history.

Built in 1900 as a Methodist church, Dorsey Chapel served as the social and spiritual center of Brookland, an African American farming community. When the chapel was scheduled for demolition in 1980, the Friends of Dorsey Chapel organized to preserve the church.

Greenbelt Museum

Greenbelt is a planned community that was designed and built by the federal government during the Great Depression. Under President Franklin D. Roosevelt, the project put many unemployed people to work building the original town, while also creating homes for families of modest income during a severe housing shortage. Greenbelt is one of three federal "greentowns" (the others are Greendale, WI, and Greenhills, OH). In 1997, Greenbelt became a National Historic Landmark. The Greenbelt Museum includes an original international-style house near the town's center that is restored and furnished with objects from the period of 1936-1946.

Major Thomas Snowden and his wife, Anne, original owners of Montpelier Mansion, welcomed many distinguished guests into their home, including George Washington and Abigail Adams.

Skilled interpreters lead tours of the farm, highlighting the colonial structures, fields, gardens, and animals.

Four interpretive signs provide a self-guided tour and describe the archaeology of the many enslaved and free African Americans who lived in the quarters from the 1790s until the 1940s. A paved path leads to the two foundations and interpretive signs. Group tours and school programs can be arranged by appointment.

Since its construction, Poplar Hill has been home to many prominent families, including the Darnalls, the Sewalls, the Daingerfelds, the Bruces, Dunhams, and Waltons. Open by appointment only.

Restored and reopened as a museum in 2011, it is one of the best examples of a Rosenwald School in the Washington DC Metro area.

Riversdale House Museum

Riversdale, a National Historic Landmark, is an elegant Federal style manor house constructed between 1801 and 1807 for Henri Stier, a Flemish aristocrat, and completed by his daughter, Rosalie, and her husband, George Calvert, grandson of the fifth Lord Baltimore. Today, this elegant architectural gem has been restored to reflect the lifestyle of the Calverts in Federal America. Rosalie Calvert's letters, supplemented by other archival records and archaeology, are used to provide modern-day visitors with a better understanding of the period. The journal of Adam Francis Plummer, an enslaved man owned by the Calverts, provides a rare first-person account of African American life in 19th century Maryland.

The Seabrook Schoolhouse was built in 1896 by the residents of the Seabrook community and provided education for grades one through eight until the early 1950s. This one-room schoolhouse is one of the few surviving one-room schoolhouses in Prince George's. The building is unique in that it was built to resemble the Victorian Gothic architectural style of the cottages that were originally built in the community. The schoolhouse has been restored and continues its legacy of education. It is open for tours by appointment and features a multi-faceted, overall program that includes interpretive exhibits, artifacts and programs.

Snow Hill Manor

Snow Hill Manor is a 2-story brick plantation house of late Georgian style located on 15 acres of land and used primarily for small meetings and event rentals. Situated on a knoll overlooking the Patuxent River, the home was built in 1755 alongside a main road connecting it to the highway leading to Philadelphia and New York. One of many homes in the Laurel area formerly owned by the distinguished Snowden family, Snow Hill Manor has been listed on the National Register of Historic Places since 1974.

Surratt House Museum

Originally built as a middle-class farm house for John and Mary Surratt in 1852, the Surratt House is infamously connected to the assassination of President Abraham Lincoln. During the crucial decade before the Civil War, the house served as a tavern and hostelry, a post office, and a polling place. During the War, it was a safe house in the Confederate underground system which flourished in Southern Maryland. Today, the museum presents a variety of programs and events, recapturing the history of the mid-19th century life and focusing on the fascinating web of the Lincoln assassination conspiracy and the involvement of the Surratt family.

Take a guided tour of one of our parks or attend one of our seasonal education programs. Enjoy the incredible scenic beauty of our parks and natural areas and document your visit with a few colorful snapshots.

Be sure to adjust your aperture for fantastic close-up wildlife photos along the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Tour. It offers a unique opportunity to learn about the outstanding natural resources of the Chesapeake Bay on the Patuxent River. The four-mile roadway connects the **Jug Bay Natural Area Trail** with the **Merkle Wildlife Sanctuary**.

A BEAUTIFUL SANCTUARY

Merkle Wildlife Sanctuary is the only wildlife sanctuary operated by the Maryland Department of Natural Resources. It is the wintering ground for several thousand Canada geese, the largest concentration of geese on the western shore of the Chesapeake Bay.

WILD & BEAUTIFUL IS THE REFUGE

Patuxent Research Refuge, home of the National Wildlife Visitor Center. Established in 1936 by executive order of President Franklin D. Roosevelt, the Patuxent Research Refuge is the Nation's only National Wildlife Refuge established to support wildlife research. With land surrounding the Patuxent and Little Patuxent Rivers between Washington DC and Baltimore, MD, the Refuge has grown from the original 2,670 acres to its present size of 12,841 acres.

Bladensburg Waterfront Park

Bladensburg Waterfront Park, formerly known as Bladensburg Marina, is a park along the Anacostia River, nestled among the Port Towns of Bladensburg, Colmar Manor and Cottage City. The park features canoe, kayak, paddleboat, and bicycle/tricycle rentals, a public boat ramp, fishing pier, picnic pavilion, playground, a B & O Railroad caboose, community boathouse (storage facility) and historical displays. Interpretive pontoon river boat tours allow visitors to explore this surprisingly scenic river with the guidance of a naturalist. Canoeing and kayaking lessons are offered, as well as guided hikes and bikes rides, among many other interesting natural and historical programs. Special events include the annual Port Towns Day, Arts at the Waterfront concert series, various cultural festivals, and river clean-ups events. The hiker/biker bridge links this park directly to the Anacostia Tributary Trail System, and connects to Washington, D.C. via the new Anacostia River Trail.

Very few colonists enjoyed such luxury. The majority were poorer planters, tenant farmers, indentured servants, and slaves. Skilled interpreters lead tours of the National Colonial Farm, highlighting the colonial structures, fields, gardens and animals.
