The Civil War Trunks are designed around two people from very different and diverse backgrounds, William B. Ott, and Daniel Corrigan. Both traveled to Prince William County and fought in battles here during the war. These trunks give teachers and students tools and resources to enhance the classroom experience. The letters, diary entries, and reports are transcriptions of primary source material. These items are just as they appeared on the original page including occasional misspelling.

Each trunk costs \$30.00 for a one week. Historic Preservation Division staff can conduct a day program with trunks at a cost of \$50.00.

Trunks are light weight plastic and on wheels for easy transportation. Wood trunks can be made available to transfer items to in the class room for enhanced visual effect. Teachers are responsible for picking up and dropping off the trunks at the Historic Preservation office;
