Spectacular year-round, the jagged peaks often showcase a dusting of snow. Highlights include The Remarkables, Cecil Peak, Walter Peak, and Ben Lomond.

For accommodations with stunning mountain vistas in the heart of Queenstown, consider Sofitel Queenstown Hotel and Spa, which offers views of Cecil Peak and The Remarkables.

ROOMS WITH A LAKE VIEW





Queenstown scenic flights offer an exceptional way to see the beautiful region.


View the stunning alpine and lake scenery from the air with a scenic helicopter, fixed-wing flight, hot air balloon or flight charter.

DAY TRIPS

Queenstown is an excellent base for exploring the breathtaking Sounds, especially for clients staying longer.

Iconic Milford Sound is accessible via self-drive, coach, helicopter, or fixed-wing plane. A great option is to take a coach one way and fly back for stunning views. Several cruise companies offer scenic tours of the fiords. Milford Sound is spectacular in any weather, with rain enhancing the beauty of its waterfalls.

A 45-minute drive northwest of Queenstown leads to Glenorchy, a slice of New Zealand paradise. The scenic drive along the lake is unforgettable, and a stop at Bennett Bluff is a must for photos. Surrounded by snow-capped mountains and ancient beech forests, Glenorchy has been a backdrop for films like The Hobbit. It's the gateway to famous hikes, including the Routeburn Track, and offers plenty of outdoor activities.

Just 20 minutes from Queenstown, Arrowtown is a historic gold mining town rich in heritage. Its charming streets, preserved buildings, and vibrant food scene make it a must-visit destination. Highlights include the Chinese miners' village, gold panning in the Arrow River, the Lakes District Museum, and boutique shopping.
