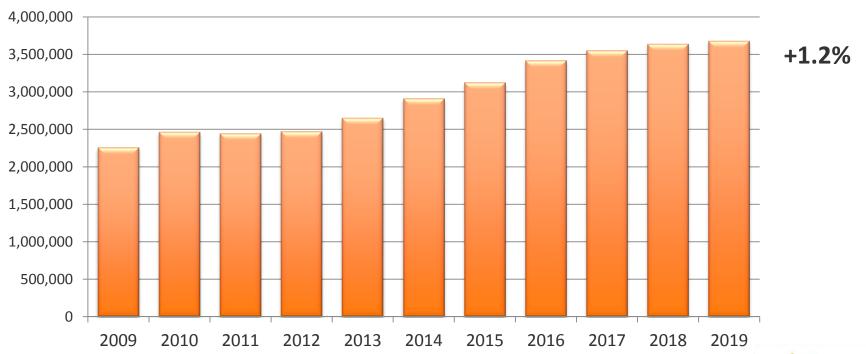






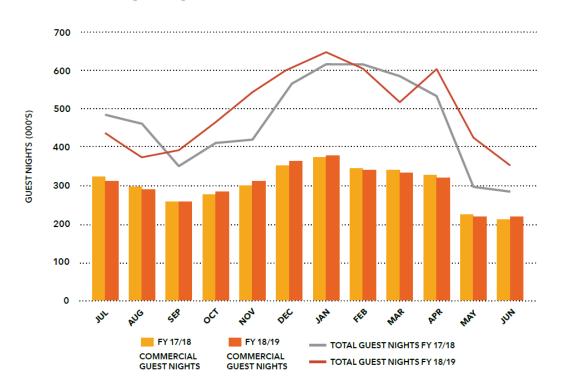


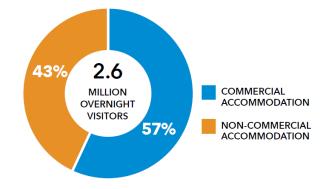
Queenstown Guest nights CAM - YE June 2019



Overnight Visitors Queenstown - YE June

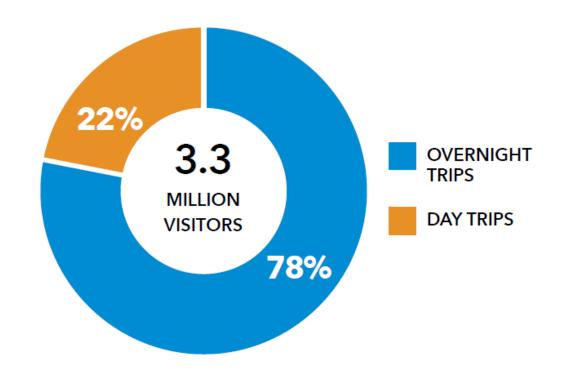

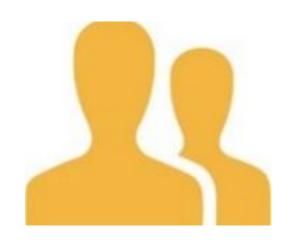




Total Visitors Queenstown – YE June

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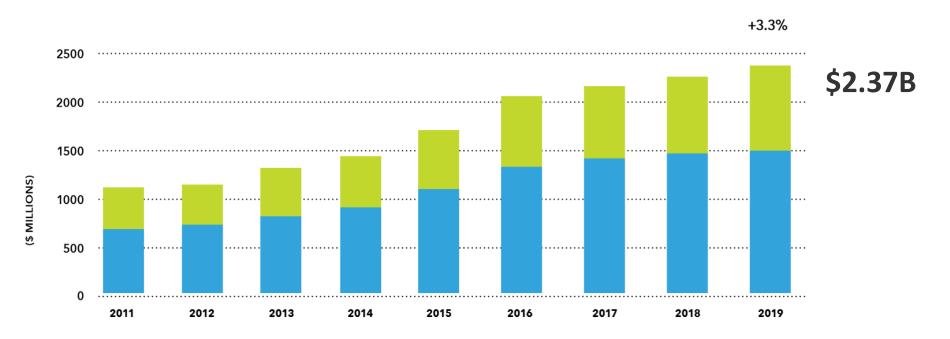

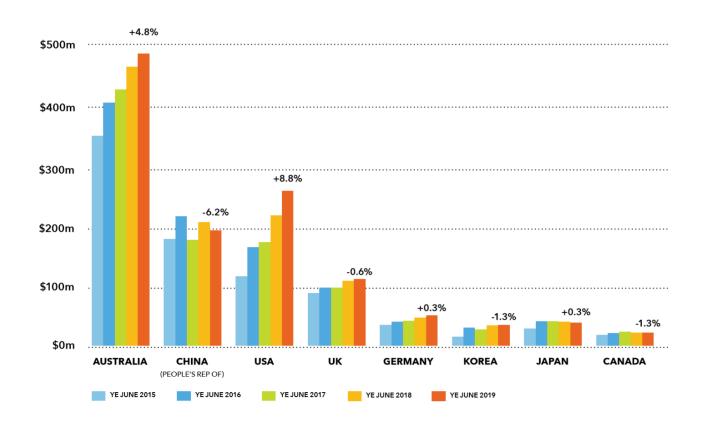


Queenstown Visitor Expenditure YE June 2019

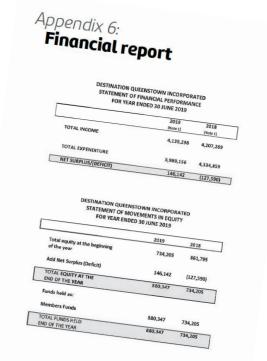
