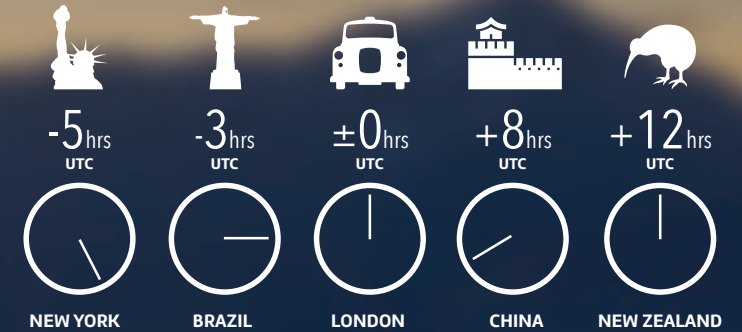


ANNUAL QUEENSTOWN COMMERCIAL GUEST NIGHTS

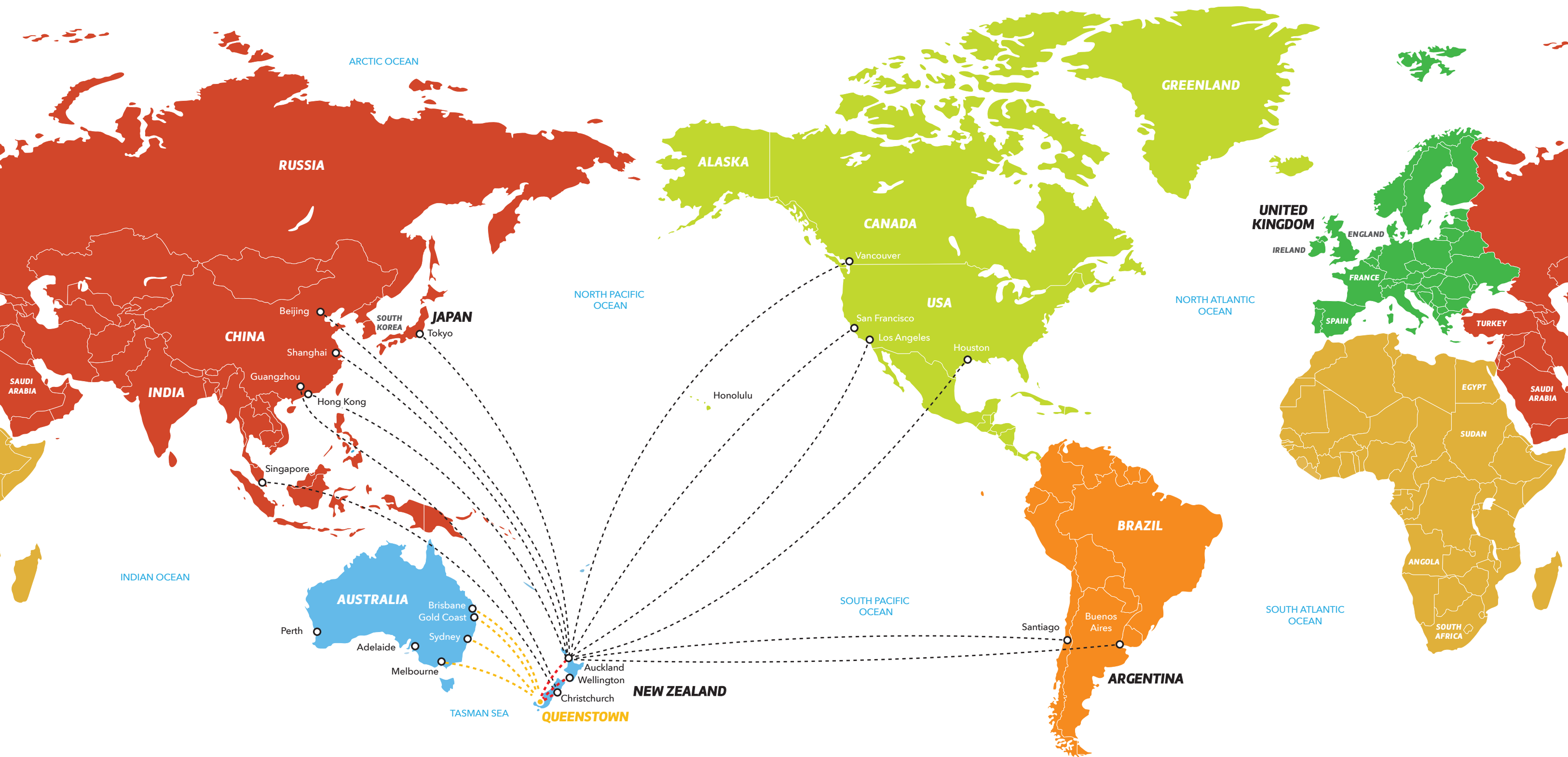

LONG-HAUL FLIGHT ROUTES

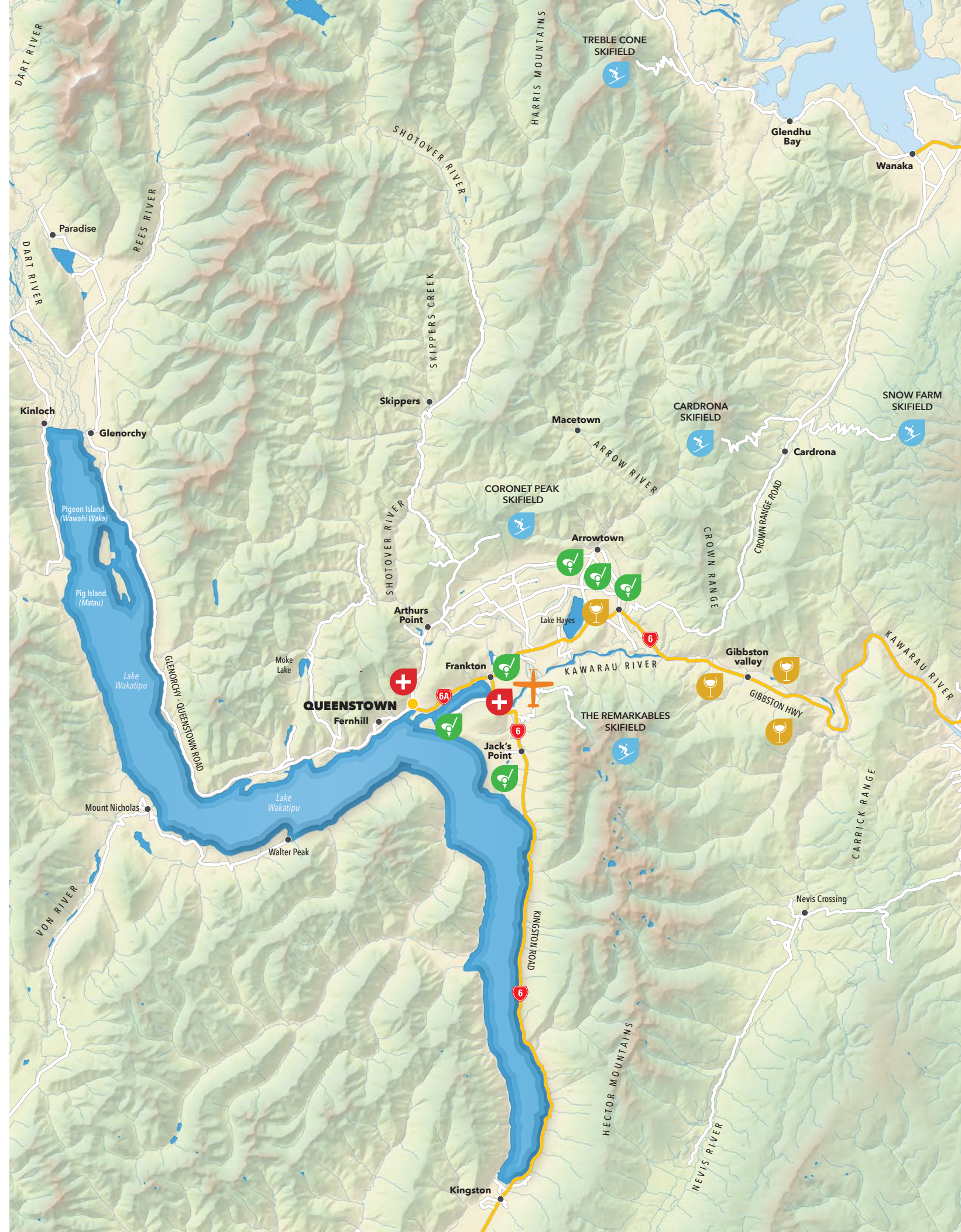

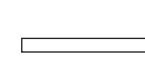

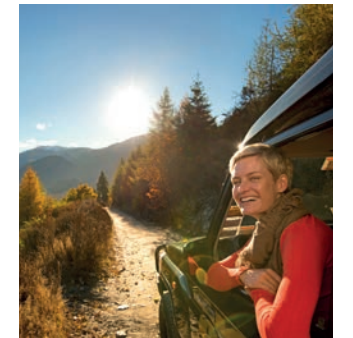

Accommodation

HOMESTAY

(or private board)

With a homestay you live with a Queenstown family in their home, usually in a fully furnished room of your own. They'll provide you with meals and help you to settle in to day-to-day life in New Zealand. A homestay is a great way to get to know some friendly New Zealanders, develop your English skills and get a close-up look at Queenstown's way of life and culture.

Meals are often included and you'll find a lively programme of social activities. Some of the institutions also provide private hostels that run in a similar way, and some have self-contained apartments (which we call 'flats').

HOUSE/ROOM RENTAL

(or independent 'flatting')

Flats range from one-bedroom apartments to four or five bedroom homes, and can be found in most Queenstown suburbs. Most suburbs are accessible by public transport, and flats include basic equipment such as an oven, dishwasher, washing machine and clothes dryer. You and your flatmates will share the cost of rent and usually the phone and energy bills.

HALLS OF RESIDENCE

(or hostels)

Accessible by public transport to the campus, halls of residence offer fully furnished single or share rooms with a shared dining hall, lounge and laundry.



Working

Most international students are able to work part time, for up to 20 hours per week while studying. Some institutions also offer the opportunity of full time work during internships.

As a result of Queenstown's strong tourism infrastructure as a year-round resort there is ample opportunity for you to secure full time or part time employment in the many hotels, adventure operations, restaurants, cafés and bars. Opportunities also exist to work within the many retail outlets.

Working while studying can be a good way to gain New Zealand work experience and help support you while you're studying abroad. Gaining experience of a New Zealand workplace also helps you develop skills such as communication, teamwork, timekeeping, interpersonal skills and workplace-relevant English language skills.

ABOUT THE FOUNDATION STUDIES CERTIFICATE

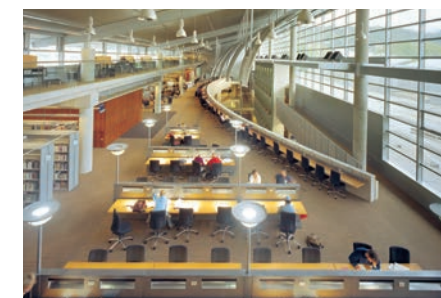
Provided by the University of Otago and Queenstown Resort College (QRC), the Foundation Studies Certificate is taught from the QRC Queenstown campus. These two institutions maintain a high standard of excellence in education and are dedicated to exemplary pastoral care.

The Foundation Studies Certificate combines the expertise of both institutions, providing a perfect starting point for students to receive the necessary English language tuition and foundation academic knowledge required for admission into a New Zealand University.

Delivered over two full time semesters, the Foundation Studies Certificate can be completed within one year of study.

Students will study in one of two streams (Arts or Commerce), with each stream containing ten papers. Both streams include the two compulsory papers, Academic English 1 and 2. Students will develop communication and problem solving skills, equipping them with the knowledge required for undergraduate study.

Upon successful completion, students will meet the academic requirements for University Entrance (UE) for University of Otago undergraduate degrees in Business and Humanities.

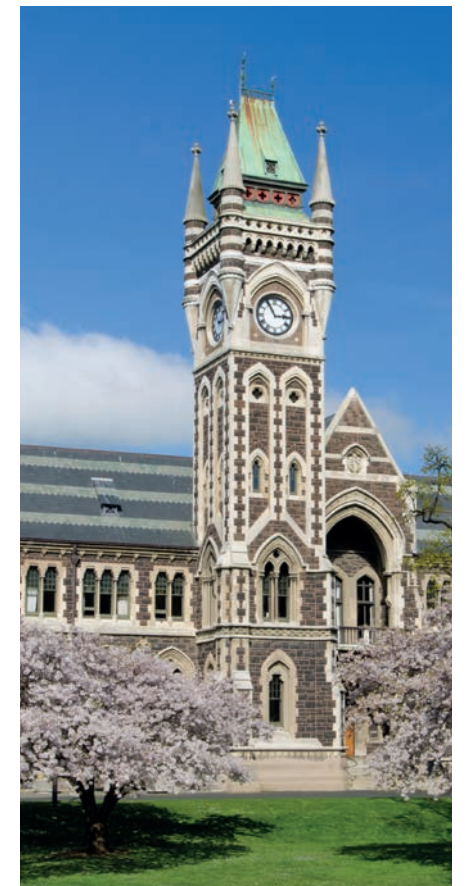

THE CODE OF PRACTICE FOR PASTORAL CARE OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

WHAT IS THE CODE OF PRACTICE?

When students come to study in New Zealand, education providers have an important responsibility to ensure that those students are well informed, safe and properly cared for.

To support this, the New Zealand government has developed a Code of Practice for the Pastoral Care of International Students (the Code).

The Code is a document that provides a framework for service delivery by education providers and their agents to international students.

It sets out minimum standards of advice and care that can be expected and provides a procedure that students can follow if they have concerns about the treatment they receive from their education provider or agent of a provider.

WHO DOES THE CODE APPLY TO?

All education providers which enrol international students must be signatories to the Code.

WHAT DOES THE CODE SAY?

The Code sets standards for education providers to ensure that:

- High professional standards are maintained
- The recruitment of international students is undertaken in an ethical and responsible manner
- Information supplied to international students is comprehensive, accurate and up-to-date
- Students are provided with information prior to entering into any commitments
- Contractual dealings with international students are conducted in an ethical and responsible manner
- The particular needs of international students are recognised
- International students are in safe accommodation
- All providers have fair and equitable internal procedures for the resolution of international student grievances
