

JACKS POINT



With a backdrop of 2300 vertical meters of the Remarkables mountain range and stunning lake views, Jack's Point Golf Course is among the most visually spectacular in the world. This 18-hole par 72 championship course offers an exciting challenge with five tee positions, ensuring an unforgettable experience for all golfers.

Designed to blend with the natural landscape, the course spans 6388 meters (6986 yards) and weaves through native tussock grasslands, dramatic rock outcrops, and lush bushland to the edge of Lake Whakatipu. Located beneath the Remarkables, Jack's Point is just 20 minutes from Queenstown.



MILLBROOK RESORT



Home of the New Zealand Open, Millbrook is one of the most scenic golf courses in the world, offering an unforgettable Queenstown golfing experience.

This 36-hole championship course features two 18-hole layouts—the Coronet 18 and the Remarkables 18—set in a natural amphitheater that maximises the stunning terrain for players of all levels.

Boasting residential and visitor accommodation as well as F&B and spa services on site.

Millbrook has a legacy of accolades, recently being awarded New Zealand's Best Golf Hotel at the 2023 World Golf Awards.



QUEENSTOWN GOLF CLUB



Queenstown Golf Club is renowned as the most scenic golf course in New Zealand. Located on the sunny Peninsula, it is surrounded on three sides by Lake Whakatipu, with the rugged Remarkables in the background. This 18-hole course, the closest to Queenstown, offers excellent golfing conditions year-round, thanks to summer and winter sun and minimal frost.

Clubs and a modern fleet of motorised carts are available for hire. Practice facilities include a driving range, chipping green, and putting greens, with lessons from our resident PGA Professionals. A fully stocked pro shop offers clothing and essentials for your round.



ARROWTOWN GOLF CLUB



The picturesque Arrowtown Golf Club is located a 25-minute drive from Queenstown, in one of New Zealand's most historic and scenic regions.

This 18-hole course is a must-visit when playing golf in Queenstown, offering superb views from every fairway, surrounded by mountains.

Each hole has its own charm, and the diverse, challenging course attracts players from around the globe. Historic stone cottage ruins nestle among towering trees, reflecting Arrowtown's rich heritage.

Golf clubs, trundlers, and electric carts are available for hire. The club is open year-round and welcomes green fee players.



FRANKTON GOLF CLUB



Situated beneath the stunning Remarkables, this gentle 9-hole golf course is perfect for both novices and experienced players.

Conveniently located near the Queenstown Events Centre and Queenstown International Airport, Frankton Golf Centre offers residents and visitors an affordable, well-maintained facility to play and learn golf.

Whether you're looking for a casual game or an activity to fill your spare time, Frankton Golf Centre is the ideal destination.

Facilities include a 9-hole course, driving range, FootGolf course, large putting/chipping green, NZPGA qualified coaching, and a fully stocked pro shop.



THE HILLS



Sir Michael Hill's private golf course in Arrowtown, designed by Darby Partners, opened in 2007 to host The New Zealand Open. Spanning 500 acres across a glacial valley, The Hills features an incredible array of flora, including native grasses and mountain tussocks. Sculptures by New Zealand artists enhance the natural beauty of the lakes and wetlands. The 6596-meter par 72 championship course boasts elevated tees offering stunning views, with no parallel fairways and unique holes. While primarily private, The Hills accepts a limited number of visitor bookings daily, providing access to the clubhouse, driving range, and restaurant for breakfast and lunch.



GOLF SERVICES

The Queenstown Golf Collective Superpass offers a round at Arrowtown, Jack's Point, Millbrook, and Queenstown golf courses for \$399.

Over The Top Golf features one of the world's most picturesque holes, located 4,500 feet above Queenstown. This par-3 experience includes three tee boxes for golfers to attempt a hole-in-one. Accessible only by helicopter, players fly in, play the hole, and return. All necessary gear is provided.

Peak Golf Queenstown caters to all skill levels, offering comprehensive information on local courses, green fees, tournaments, and guided or self-drive tours.

Remarkables Golf Tours provides transport, tee-time reservations, green fee packages, and equipment hire, ensuring a memorable experience for golf groups of all sizes.

Golf Federation features four fully equipped golf simulator bays for hire in central Queenstown, perfect for family and friends to enjoy together.
