













Note: Visitor expenditure refers to money spent on tourism-related activities. DQ LWT use Marketview visitor spend figures as our expenditure measure. Marketview visitor expenditure reflects in-person card transactions only, so it excludes cash, online, and app-based payments. It is not adjusted for inflation, and it captures electronic card transactions processed through Queenstown and Wānaka terminals only. As booking and payment channels continue to shift, this dataset is becoming less representative of total visitor spend. 




