**1. Effortless Collection:** We provide the collection bins to suit your business needs. Your team disposes of food waste into the bin provided. We will collect the bins once or twice a week, depending on your needs.

**2. Transformation Process:** Collected food waste is managed using streamlined composting systems at our local processing site. Through our aerobic process, organic matter is broken down into nutrient-rich compost, ready to nourish new plant life.
