All employees and airport guests are required to wear a face covering at all times in the airport. Free masks are available in the terminals.

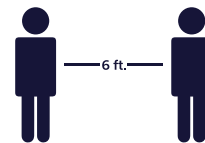
## Hand Sanitizer

Free hand sanitizer stations are conveniently located throughout the terminals.



## Plexiglas Barriers

Plexiglas sneeze guards are installed in public spaces to separate airport workers and guests.



## Social Distancing

Physical and digital signage, overhead announcements, floor stickers and seat covers throughout the airport remind guests to maintain appropriate distance and follow public health best practices.



## Terminal Operations Team

A team of airport workers monitor cleaning and disinfecting practices, assist with managing lines and ensure compliance with public health guidelines.

## Contactless Experience

The ParkRDU online booking system provides a contactless journey and many terminal stores and restaurants offer digital menus and contactless payment.



## Airport and Airline Health and Safety Measures:

RDU is taking action to provide a safe and reassuring experience for everyone who visits and works at the airport. Janitorial staff have enhanced the cleaning and disinfecting practices with products that eliminate COVID-19. The ticketing areas, security checkpoints, bathrooms, gate waiting areas and high-touch surfaces such as ticket counters, kiosks, handrails and doorknobs are cleaned and disinfected regularly.

Airlines have increased their airplane cleaning procedures, modified boarding practices and encourage passengers to follow public health best practices. All airlines serving RDU require passengers to wear a mask to board the plane and during flight. According to the CDC, most viruses and other germs do not spread easily on flights because of how air circulates and is filtered on airplanes. Commercial aircraft have medical-grade HEPA filters that remove 99.9% of particles from the air, including viruses like COVID-19.
