

Other Attractions

While visiting Downtown Asheboro you'll find that you're centrally located to visit numerous exciting attractions in the area. A must-visit destination is the North Carolina Zoo, only a few miles from Downtown Asheboro and a treat for all ages.



The North Carolina Zoo is the largest land mass zoo in the world and is currently undergoing an

expansion to add animals from Asia. The North Carolina Zoo, including Asheboro and the surrounding Randolph County area, also boast 19+ hiking trails from easy to hard for hiking enthusiasts.



For baseball fans, the Asheboro ZooKeepers Baseball team competes in the Coastal Plain League, an all-wooden bat league at the historic McCrary Ballpark in the summer season.

History buffs will be enchanted with memorabilia from WWI to the present that include an impressive collection of military artifacts, vehicles, weapons, equipment, uniforms, vintage airplanes, and a flight simulator at the North Carolina Aviation Museum and Hall of Fame. Do not miss viewing the Piper J-3 "Flitfire" flown by Orville Wright!



The largest private collection of antique Harley-Davidson® motorcycles



in the country – 45 bikes from 1936 – 1978, can be found at the American Classic Motorcycle Museum. It includes a gift shop and Heritage Diner on site. To




About Asheboro
