



## LAKE USER FEES

### **Daily Boat Launch Fee:**

City Resident ( <i>with Rec Card</i> )	\$7.00
Non- Resident	\$9.50

### **Daily Canoe/Kayak Launch Fee:**

City Resident ( <i>with Rec Card</i> )	\$2.50
Non- Resident	\$3.50

### **Annual Boat Launch Permit:**

City Resident ( <i>with Rec Card</i> )	\$100.00
Non- Resident	\$135.00

### **Annual Canoe/Kayak Launch Permit:**

City Resident ( <i>with Rec Card</i> )	\$35.00
Non- Resident	\$50.00

## REC CARDS

To receive the City Resident Rate, a current Rec Card is required. Rec Cards are issued free of charge and are available to all residents who live within the city limits of Asheboro. A government issued picture ID and a current utility bill with the same address are required to obtain the Rec Card. ## RULES & REGULATIONS

- No person shall fish, launch a boat or have any contact whatsoever with Lake Reese except at the designated entry points provided by the City of Asheboro.
- Any person using Lake Reese must have a valid permit issued by the Park Manager or authorized staff member.
- All persons using the lake shall sign in at the office.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed.
- Swimming is not permitted.
- Boats, canoes, kayaks and sail boats are all permitted on Lake Reese. Jet skis and similar personal watercraft along with windsurf boards and waterskiing are **NOT** permitted on the lake.
- All boats must have one US Coast Guard approved lifejacket per occupant.
- No person under 16 years of age shall be permitted to operate a powerboat.
- Motor size: Unlimited. Speed limit: 25mph.
- All boats must be off lake 30 minutes prior to sunset.
- NC Inland Fishing regulations shall be enforced and adhered to at Lake Reese.
- Minimum age for fishing is 16, unless accompanied by an adult.
- Bank fishing is allowed only at designated areas.
- No littering in the Lake or on Park Property.
- Check out at office when leaving.
- Problems should be reported to the Park Manager immediately.
