Role Description Overview

The City View Trolley Driver is responsible for driving trolleys in a safe manner for a variety of city tours, shuttles, and private charters. This role helps maintain safe and clean trolleys and completes required inspections and paperwork.

Key Qualifications

The City View Trolley Driver embodies a flexible, creative, and entrepreneurial spirit, showcasing a deep-seated passion for the mission, vision, and values of VRC. Demonstrating a capacity for safely driving CDL-required vehicles and strong customer service skills, it is expected that this role excels at operating the trolley and engaging with riders while holding a genuine connection to the community and values central to VRC's mission.

Key Responsibilities

- Safe operation of the trolley in all weather conditions.
- General knowledge of Rapid City, to include attractions and events.
- Display strong public relations skills by presenting Rapid City, Visit Rapid City, and City View Trolley in a positive view.
- Maintain working knowledge of streets, current routes, and fare structure.
- Conduct pre-trip and post-trip inspections of trolley for each tour.
- Ensure cleanliness of trolley before and after tours.
- Ability to operate trolley wheelchair lift and properly secure mobility devices. Willing to aid passengers with disabilities while boarding/deboarding the trolley.
- Maintain necessary licensing and training certifications to meet city, state, and federal requirements.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

- Ability to obtain and maintain a valid CDL driver license with A, B, C Endorsements, P=Passenger
- Ability to maintain a clean driving record
- Ability to communicate effectively and courteously in a professional manner
- Ability to narrate tour if necessary
- Ability to lift and carry objects up to 50 pounds on occasion
- Ability to lift and carry objects up to 30 pounds frequently
- Ability to sit, stand, and squat
- Ability to hear and see
- Ability to stay alert at all times
- Ability to be in attendance when scheduled and to arrive promptly for the start of the work day
- Ability to work flexible hours to include evenings and weekends
- Ability to pass a drug test
- Ability to submit to a background/credit check
