

Visit Rapid City | Survey Report

July 9, 2021 – July 20, 2022

Overview

This was a Resident Sentiment Survey that collected responses throughout July. The survey was distributed digitally through the Facebook Ad Network.

Highlights

Most respondents have lived in Rapid City for over 20 years.

There was a positive distribution in participants' age with older respondents being the most engaged.

Visiting family and friends typically stay with a relative/friend or at a hotel.

Primary things/activities friends and family enjoy in Rapid City are restaurants/dining, attractions, and visiting parks/memorials/monuments. Sightseeing, shopping, outdoor recreation, and visiting downtown are not far off from the top. Very few respondents selected cultural activities or museums/galleries.

The natural environment and small community (family and friends included) were top values.

Accessible transportation was the biggest want with a slew of individual responses/ideas.

Most respondents saw value in tourism for Rapid City.


Respondents' perceptions of Rapid City have lightly skewed more negatively and neutral over the last year. They are a lot of responses on why the perceptions have changed.




















