**Proposed changes in Oklahoma alcohol rules to be discussed during  
Hospitality Legal Series Nov. 3**

STILLWATER, Okla.—Oklahoma State University’s School of Hotel and Restaurant Administration is set to host the Hospitality Legal Series featuring State Sen. Stephanie Bice on Nov. 3 at 6 p.m. in the North Wing of the College of Human Sciences.

Bice will be the inaugural speaker to launch the Hospitality Legal Series at OSU by discussing Oklahoma State Question 792, Oklahoma regulations governing the sale of wine and beer, on the November 8<sup>th</sup> ballot. The purpose of the series is to present two to three speakers throughout the academic school year on legal issues related to the hospitality industry.
