Agenda item 3:

The applicant seeks incentives under the Rebuild Rhode Island Tax Credit program in relation to a mixed-use complex which is expected to include 136 apartments and 10,000 square feet of office and retail space in West Warwick. The total development cost for the project is estimated at approximately \$31.5 million.

Agenda item 4:

The applicant seeks incentives under the Rebuild Rhode Island Tax Credit program in relation to a mixed-use complex which is expected to include 228 apartments and 20,000 square feet of commercial space in Providence. The total development cost for the project is estimated at approximately \$46.2 million.
