The Heart Beet from George's of Galilee in Narragansett, Rhode Island

Get your heart 'BEETing' with this bold blend of Don Julio [tequila](#), Legendario [rum](#), beetroot shrub, orgeat and lime, which can be found at the beloved neighborhood restaurant [George's of Galilee](#) in Narragansett, Rhode Island. Their master alchemist Sara Messier calls it "a vibrant, earthy delight that balances sweetness and tang," plus that beetroot rose is too pretty not to recreate.

Ingredients:

- 1 oz Don Julio Tequila
- 1 oz Rum Legendário Elixir 7 Anos
- 1 oz beetroot shrub
- ½ oz Orgeat
- 0.75 oz fresh lime juice
- 7 dashes fee foam
- Very thinly sliced beet and baby's breath, for garnish

Directions:

1. In a shaker, combine Don Julio tequila, Legendario rum, beetroot shrub, orgeat, lime juice and fee foam.
2. Fill the shaker with ice and shake vigorously for about 15-20 seconds until well chilled.
3. Strain the cocktail into a chilled coupe glass.
4. Garnish with a thin slices of beet shaped like a rose petal and baby's breath.
