EAST NARRAGANSETT BAY, EAST PROVIDENCE TO NEWPORT, RHODE ISLAND

Ease into <u>Rhode Island</u>'s historic Newport from points north on RI 114, a more local and scenic alternative to I-95 or I-195. On the <u>30-mile drive</u>, visit Bristol's <u>Colt State Park</u> to walk the bayside trails and experience 18th-century farm life at <u>Coggeshall Farm Museum</u>. In Middletown, try the Portuguese fish chowder at <u>Anthony's Seafood</u> and tour <u>Newport Vineyards' winery</u>.
