Vatn Systems, Inc. | Portsmouth | \$73,468 | Manufacturing Voucher | Vatn Systems, Inc. (“Vatn”) builds affordable autonomous underwater vehicles (AUVs) for advanced maritime applications. Vatn will use voucher funding to integrate an innovative wireless charging system for their AUVs which would enable charging underwater as well as dry land without any external connection. This technology will improve durability and operational efficiency of the vehicle, while creating the possibility for a second stage of innovation that includes autonomous charging at an underwater station.
