They will prototype a new animatronics system and integration of real-time engagement between caregivers and pets that will enhance the products' efficacy and expressiveness.

Foxglove, LLC | Narragansett | \$75,000 | Manufacturing | Foxglove, LLC will use voucher funding to prototype and test their novel solution to inopportune female urination. Foxglove's MittyPak product has dual-use potential for women in mission-critical roles, as well as by those experiencing incontinence.

HA Biosciences | Providence | \$75,000 | Knowledge Provider | HA Biosciences is developing a novel, science-backed product for individuals with Irritable Bowel Syndrome (IBS). With voucher funding, they will partner with Women & Infants Hospital to conduct a clinical study, a critical step in advancing the solution toward commercialization.

The AnalytIQ | North Kingstown | \$75,000 | Knowledge Provider | The AnalytIQ is developing a wearable textile system that monitors vital signs in real time to detect and prevent heat-related illnesses. With voucher funding, AnalytIQ will partner with the University of Rhode Island to develop the prototype, integrate biosensors, and test the product in athletic settings. AnalytIQ's wearable system will be used for multiple applications including military training, athletics, and other heat-intensive occupations.
