Statement of Duties

The President for Rhode Island Commerce Corporation, a quasi-governmental agency, is appointed by the Commerce Secretary. The incumbent serves as the Executive Counselor to the Governor on Economic Growth and Community Development and participates on a number of interagency cabinet level commissions.

Position Functions

The essential functions and duties listed below are intended only as illustration of the various types of work that may be performed. The omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the position if work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to the position.

Essential Functions

- Directs all senior level activities of the Corporation in an effort to promote high wage job growth.
- Serves as the Corporation's liaison with the legislature, external agencies and private groups to develop and maintain working relationships.
- Oversees community and project-development activities.
- Performs all other related projects as requested by the Governor's office and legislative branches.
