DOMESTIC

Providence, Rhode Island

Known as Rhode Island's creative capital, Providence is one of the country's most diverse and vibrant cities for the arts, due in large part as the home to The Rhode Island of School of Design (RISD) which cultivates a creative community. Providence's artistic offerings are best experienced on foot via <u>Avenue Concept</u>, Rhode Island's first privately funded public art program. They offer two self-guided <u>tours</u> offering comprehensive stops with dozens of murals and sculptures to visit in Downtown and South Side/West End. As of August, a new <u>latinx-led public art banner project</u> honoring the healthcare workers who have helped manage the COVID-19 crisis has launched throughout the city.
