Book a haunted stay, if you dare. [The General Stanton Inn](#) began welcoming guests in 1740. Staff and guests report seeing ghostly apparitions including General Stanton himself. Housed in a former jail in Newport, Rhode Island, [The Jailhouse Inn](#) is a popular spot for paranormal investigations. Formerly The Biltmore Hotel, [Graduate by Hilton Providence](#) is one of the most haunted hotels in the country.
