The Vanderbilt, Auberge Resorts Collection - Newport, Rhode Island

This former private mansion built by a Vanderbilt scion is now a [luxurious hotel](#) set around a delightful outdoor courtyard, where dogs are often welcomed at events, such as a neighborhood s'mores night around the fire pit.

A couple minutes' walk brings you to Queen Ann Square, a lovely green space at Church and Thames Street, where dogs may romp in the small park. Or you might wander further to the waterfront. Back at The Vanderbilt, four-legged guests receive bowls, beds and treats. Note that cats are allowed too.
