Beer has touched the local culture since colonial times. History and hops intertwined at taverns and breweries. Visitors today can peer into a beer cave used by D.G. Yuengling Jr.'s post-Civil War brewery. Buildings that held pre-Prohibition breweries still stand. Richmonders drank from the first beer in a can back in 1935.

THE ANSWER BREWPUB

Located in Richmond's West End, The Answer Brewpub features more than 60 taps, two bars, a pub menu with splashes of Vietnamese influence, and an exceptional stage area for live music.



ARDENT CRAFT ALES

The Scott's Addition brewery, taproom, and beer garden produces a broad range of beer styles, from IPAs and lagers to stouts and sours. Ardent also serves food as well as guest cider, wine, and non-alcoholic options.



BASIC CITY BEER CO. RVA

Basic City was born of the smolderings of a lost Virginia town. Its Industrial Age-inspired fits the 1900s RVA building, balancing history with a contemporary perspective in craft beer: a traditional approach to new beer styles ranging from stouts to double IPAs.



BENCHTOP BREWING CO.

The second location for Norfolk's Benchtop Brewing blends modern architecture and old-world charm ranging from the Baltic birch bar to the Lukr lager faucets. Benchtop pairs creativity with scientific precision for a unique experience. The in-house kitchen serves innovative hot dogs.



BINGO BEER CO.

Bingo Beer in Scott's Addition combines a brewery, full restaurant, beer garden patio, and arcade, with vintage cabinet video games, pinball, table tennis, and more. The brewery focuses on European-inspired lagers, plus a wide range of other beer styles.



CANON & DRAW BREWING CO.

Located on Main Street in the historic Fan District, Canon & Draw offers an eclectic mix of modern and traditional beer styles served on draft, with flights available. Dog friendly, pool tables, and a perfect space for private events.



CASTLEBURG BREWERY & TAPROOM

In a world where beer has ventured from four basic ingredients to flavors so overstated that they're capable of staining a pint glass, Castleburg Brewery harkens back to a time when beer was beer.



CENTER OF THE UNIVERSE BREWING

Center of the Universe Brewing Company (COTU) is a family-owned brewery, winery, and tasting room that focuses on sustainable brewing methods and commitment to community. At COTU, it all revolves around the beer, wine, cider, and those who enjoy it.



DANCING KILT BREWERY

Dancing Kilt offers beers inspired by European traditions, with 16 seasonal rotating taps. The tasting room also serves mead, cider, and wine from Moondrop Winery, as well as an eclectic mix of finger foods. The brewery is family-friendly, and outdoor seating is pet-friendly.



EXTRA BILLY'S SMOKEHOUSE & BREWERY

The second-oldest operating brewery in the Richmond area pairs its full restaurant menu with a diversity of house-brewed beers. Extra Billy's wood-smoked meats also pair well with the wines, liquors, and cocktails served at the restaurant.



FINAL GRAVITY BREWING CO.

At this friendly and knowledgeable neighborhood brewery, visitors enjoy award-winning beers in classic and popular styles. Favorites include hazy IPAs and DIPAs, sours, and more. While there, homebrewers can shop at Original Gravity homebrew shop, serving Richmond since 2011.



GARDEN GROVE BREWING & URBAN WINERY

The brewery and urban winery in historic Carytown offers a diverse selection of craft beers, wines, ciders, and meads. True to its name, Garden Grove focuses on local and organic ingredients – nothing artificial – and believes in balance, passion, and sustainability.



HARDYWOOD PARK CRAFT BREWERY

Since its inception, Hardywood has embraced local ingredients, renewable energy, and a passion for the craft of brewing. The original taproom in Richmond's historic German brewing district offers indoor and outdoor seating, live music, events, and artisanal pizza.



THE HIDDEN WIT BREWING CO.

A brewery for friends and family to retreat and unwind is tucked into the suburban landscape in a one-of-a-kind atmosphere. The full-service, farm-to-table kitchen presents food that can be paired with a beer for every palate.



INTERMISSION BEER CO.

Take a break at this woman-owned, entertainment-inspired brewery. Besides a variety of beer styles, Intermission offers pizza and pretzels from locally run Billy Pie. Enjoy inside or outside on the dog-friendly patio.



ISLEY BREWING CO.

Choosy Mother peanut butter porter, an early unexpected hit, continues as a fan favorite. Since then, Isley's craft beer lovers have embraced the range of beers and seltzers, the neighborhood atmosphere, and knowledgeable staff that enjoy engaging with guests.



LEGEND BREWING CO.

Virginia's oldest operating craft brewery opened in 1994, initiating locals on the wonders of craft beer. Legend offers a full-service food menu for pairing with its lagers and ales. The beer garden includes a spacious deck overlooking the James River.



MAIN LINE BREWERY

Main Line Brewery offers a rotating selection of craft beer and hard seltzer plus live entertainment. The wide-open venue offers indoor and outdoor seating, alongside the railroad tracks and adjacent to tasting rooms for Cirrus Vodka and Urban Rum Co.



	MOLLY'S BICYCLE SHOP AND BLIND DOG BREWERY Whether you bike or not, this family-friendly, dog-friendly brewery inside a bicycle shop can satisfy your thirst for fun. Enjoy a brew from its ever-shifting gears of styles, play games, listen to music, or just hang out inside or out.	 
	ORIGIN BEER LAB Origin Beer Lab is the research and development brewery and taproom for Center of the Universe Brewing. New techniques, ingredients, and styles pour from the taps on a constantly rotating basis right in the heart of downtown Ashland.	
	RICHBRAU BREWING With a name dating to the repeal of Prohibition, Richbrau Brewing in Shockoe Bottom brews classic and contemporary styles with names inspired by local lore. Featuring hazy IPAs, imperial stouts, and sours, the taproom offers beers for discerning and novice palates.	 
	ROCK BOTTOM RESTAURANT & BREWERY Rock Bottom Restaurant & Brewery is a national brand of 28 locations that gives creative license to local brewers. Part of Short Pump Town Center in Richmond's West End, the full-service restaurant offers craft beer brewed on-site and American fare.	  
	STARR HILL – RICHMOND BEER HALL & ROOFTOP Veteran Virginia brewery Starr Hill began in Charlottesville and now operates six satellite locations. The Richmond Beer Hall, including a rooftop bar, serves beers from Starr Hill's other locations and its own – including its foeder-aged beers – on 24 rotating taps.	
	STEAM BELL BEER WORKS Chesterfield's first production brewery and taproom specializes in goses and stouts. The tasting room offers a wide variety of other options, including local cider and wine on tap. Food truck on site daily with live music on the weekend.	 
	STONE BREWING – RICHMOND Known for producing big, bold craft beers, California-based Stone Brewing opened its Eastern U.S. brewery, packaging hall, and taproom in Richmond in 2016. The taproom offers retail sales and pours of year-round beers and special releases, plus Southern California-inspired cuisine.	 

	STRANGEWAYS The original location of this one-of-a-kind brewery always pours 36+ beers – lagers, IPAs, stouts, sours, wild ales – plus spiked seltzer, cider, and wine. Strangeways serves up food trucks, live music, events, outdoor seating, and private event space. Plus, it's open daily.	  
	STRANGEWAYS – SCOTT'S ADDITION This one-of-a-kind brewery in Scott's Addition always pours 36+ beers – lagers, IPAs, stouts, sours, wild ales – plus spiked seltzer, cider, and wine. Strangeways serves up food trucks, live music, events, outdoor seating, and private event space. Plus, it's open daily.	  
	TABOL BREWING The small-batch brewery in Richmond's Northside features an array of classic and contemporary beer styles plus its distinctive Tabol Biere, a rotating funky selection made with the house wild yeast. Enjoy inside or outside, with entertainment and food truck fare.	
	TALLEYSVILLE BREWING CO. Since this family-owned farm brewery is part of New Kent Winery, guests can enjoy wine as well as beer in a scenic countryside setting – in the tasting room, patio, and green spaces. Beers focus on classic styles and the finest farm ingredients.	  
	THREE LEG RUN BREWERY, WINERY, AND MEADERY Named for the owners' "three-leg-run" dog plus the three types of alcohol they produce: eight beers and two sessionable meads on tap plus bottled wines. Tasting room guests can choose their preferred style to enjoy indoors or on the patio.	   
	THREE NOTCH'D RVA COLLAB HOUSE The Scott's Addition brewery collaborates with the local community. The taproom features award-winning flagships from the original Three Notch'd Brewing in Charlottesville as well as its own small-batch beers, including regular fundraising collaborations.	  
	TRAPEZIUM – CHURCH HILL Situated in a converted former Masonic Temple, Trapezium Church Hill is a brewery that expands on its traditional offerings by flaunting its barrel program and blended beers. In a very unusual setting, very different from a typical industrial taproom.

	TRIPLE CROSSING – DOWNTOWN Triple Crossing's original downtown location near VCU established its reputation for quality, from hop-forward IPAs and DIPAs to traditional lagers and stouts. The tasting room offers pizza and starters and a diversity of beer, including a regular gluten-reduced golden ale.	 
	TRIPLE CROSSING – FULTON Triple Crossing's brewery in historic Fulton affords greater production plus a more spacious taproom, inside and out, for customers to enjoy the diversity of beers – from hop-forward IPAs and DIPAs to traditional lagers and stouts – plus pizzas, starters, and salads.	 
	TRIPLE CROSSING – MIDLOTHIAN The third Triple Crossing taproom carries its concepts to the suburbs. While serving the same diversity of beers – from hop-forward IPAs and DIPAs to traditional lagers and stouts – the Midlothian location also offers an elevated brewery dining experience.	 
	VÄSEN BREWING CO. Väsen's distinctive, sustainable brewing process, including beers made with kveik yeast, reflects Väsen's Scandinavian roots and emphasis on the outdoors. The foeder and barrel-aging programs create funky farmhouse ales, complemented by a variety of saisons, lagers, IPAs, stouts, and sours.	
	THE VEIL BREWING CO. The brewery's original location is also the mothership for most of its beer production. The Veil focuses on hop-forward beers, fruited sours, barrel aging, lagers, wild ales, and spontaneous fermentation. The taproom presents a modern, industrial vibe with patio seating.	
	THE VEIL – FOREST HILL The Veil continues its funky vibe in this two-level taproom with patio seating and its focus on hop-forward beers, fruited sours, lagers, and spontaneous fermentation. The taproom also offers wine, cider, and guest beer and food from Y Tu Mamá.	  
	THE VEIL FUNKHAÜST CAFÉ The casual taproom at The Veil's barrel-aging facility serves funky and wild beers, easy-drinking beers like lagers and IPAs, and pours bottles of its vintage ales, including Mixed Fermies, Lambic-inspired beers, and barrel-aged stouts. Open limited hours.

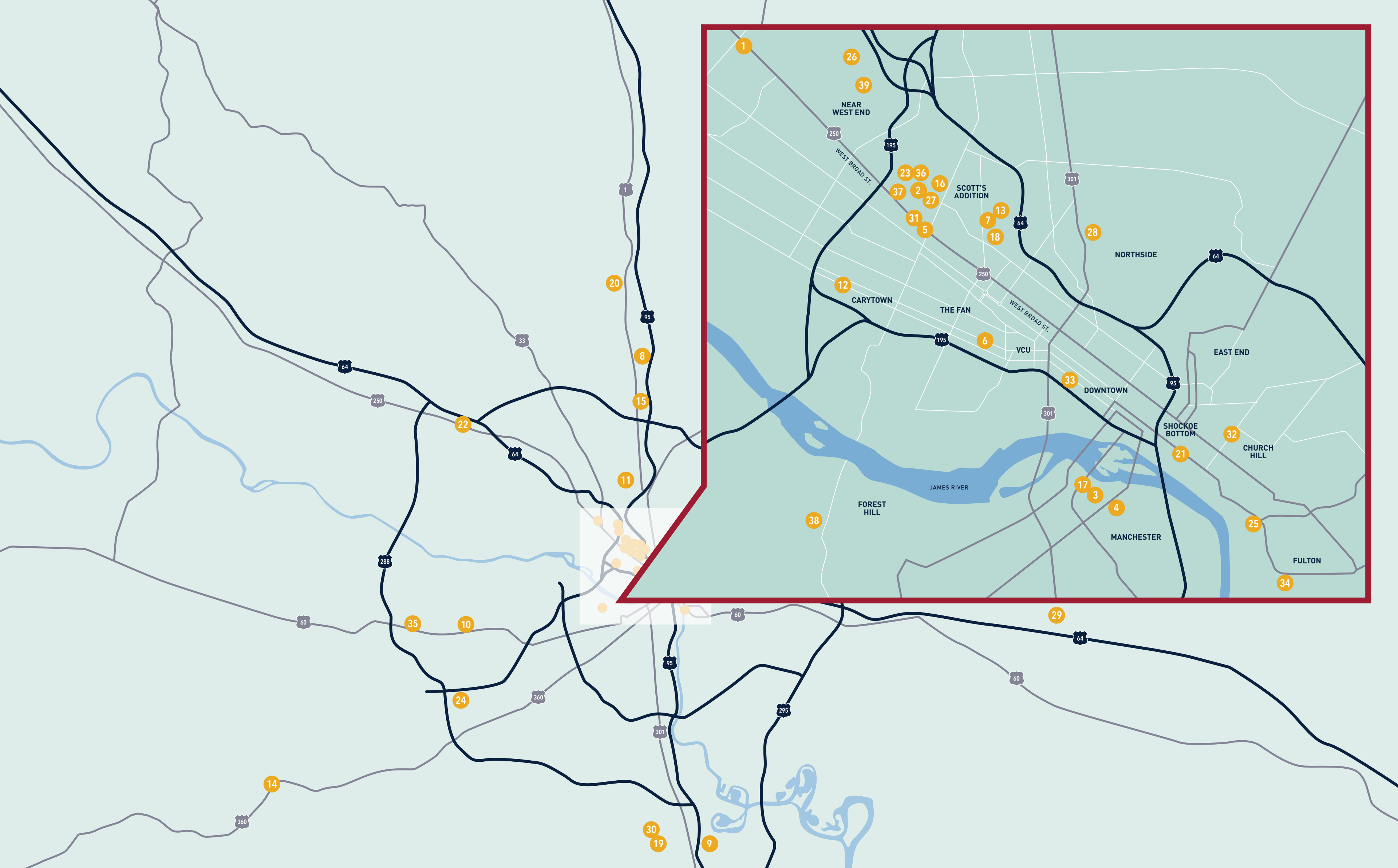
