RICHMOND MAP & DIRECTIONS

Bridgeport Station to Steveston Village

DRIVE

Approximately 25 minutes

1. Head south on Great Canadian Way towards Van Horne Way
2. Continue onto Garden City Road South
3. Turn left onto Westminster Highway
4. Turn left onto No 1 Road
5. Turn right onto Moncton Street
6. Arrive at the Tourism Richmond Visitor Centre located in the heart of Steveston Village

TRANSIT

Approximately 35 minutes

1. Wait at Bridgeport Station Bay 10
2. Take the 407 Gilbert Bus towards Steveston
3. Get off at Chatham and 2nd Avenue
4. You will arrive in the heart of Steveston Village—the Visitor Centre is a 3 minute walk from your drop off location

If you are closer to Richmond-Brighouse Station, take the 401 One Road Bus (Bay 2).

BIKE

Quickest route – 40 minutes

1. Bike along Garden City Road, then turn right onto Granville Avenue
2. Turn left onto Railway Avenue
3. Turn right onto Moncton Street and arrive at the Tourism Richmond Visitor Centre

Scenic route – 45 minutes

1. Bike towards No 3 Road and onto River Road
2. Head south along the West Dyke Trail
3. Follow the West Dyke Trail and turn left towards Moncton Street to arrive at the Tourism Richmond Visitor Centre
