BRIDGEPORT TO STEVESTON

DRIVE APPROX. 25 MINS

1. Head south on Great Canadian Way towards Van Horne Way
2. Continue onto Garden City Road South
3. Turn right onto Westminster Highway
4. Turn left onto No 1 Road
5. Turn right onto Moncton Street
6. Arrive at the Tourism Richmond Visitor Centre located in the heart of Steveston Village

TRANSIT APPROX. 35 MINS

1. Wait at Bridgeport Station Bay 10
 2. Take the 407 Gilbert Bus towards Steveston
 3. Get off at Chatham and 2nd Avenue
 4. You will arrive in the heart of Steveston Village – the Visitor Centre is a 3 minute walk from your drop off location
- If you are closer to Richmond-Brighouse Station, take the 401 One Road Bus (Bay 2).

BIKE APPROX. 45 MINS

- Quickest route: Bike along Garden City to Granville Avenue, and then head south on Railway Avenue – 40 mins
 - Scenic route: West Dyke Trail – 45 mins
- The West Dyke Trail is a more scenic and slightly longer cycling route. It hugs Richmond's coast and enjoys views out to the Georgia Strait, Gulf Islands and Vancouver Island.

1. Bike towards No 3 Road and onto River Road
2. Head south along the West Dyke Trail
3. Follow the West Dyke Trail and turn left towards Moncton Street to arrive at the Tourism Richmond Visitor Centre
