



This walk makes the most of the green spaces and woodland areas available between Laleham and Staines. The island at Penton Hook Lock is a lovely space for both you and your pooches to explore. You can vary the length of your walk by exploring more of Laleham Aork and the island.

Distance: 4miles

Duration: 1.5 hours

Difficulty: Easy

Car Park Car Parking: Several options are available.

1. Laleham Park & Riverside Lands, 218 Thames Side, Staines-upon-Thames, Staines KT16 8RN – marked on the map as an orange 1.
2. Laleham Park & Riverside Lands, 215 Thames Side, Laleham, Staines-upon-Thames, Staines TW18 1UQ – marked on the map with an orange 2.

Refreshments, and toilets: This walk is fairly quiet, so not many options for refreshments. Very near Laleham Park there is The Three Shires pub, which would be an east detour.- 25 Shepperton Road Laleham, Staines TW18 1SE.

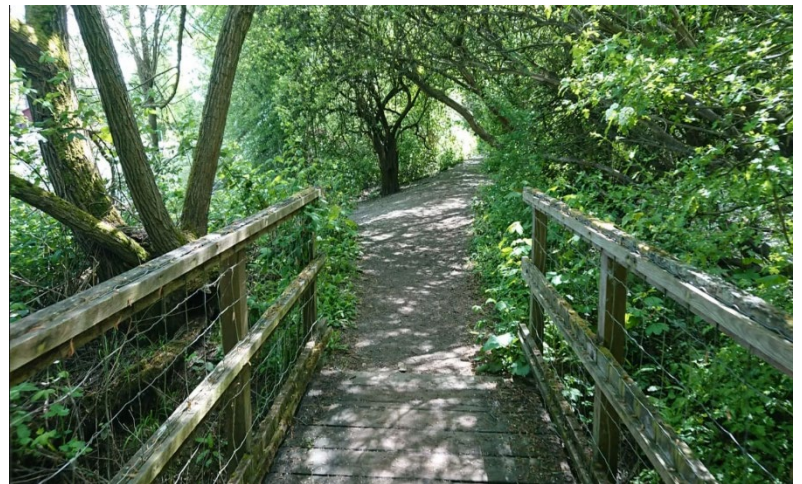
Description:

The walk starts in Laleham Park where you have a choice of two main car parks. For the slightly longer walk (0.5 miles longer), start at Laleham Park & Riverside Lands, 218 Thames Side, Staines-upon-Thames, Staines KT16 8RN – marked on the map as an orange 1. For the slightly shorter walk start at Laleham Park & Riverside Lands, 215 Thames Side, Laleham, Staines-upon-Thames, Staines TW18 IUQ – marked on the map with an orange 2. There is also separate parking available on the side of Abbey Drive, which is just a short walk to the park. | Abbey Dr, Staines-upon-Thames, Staines TW18 ISR.

Laleham Park (formerly the grounds of the Abbey) provide a wide area of open grounds and woodland for walking. The Thames Path National Trail runs alongside the river through the park. From your parking spot make your way towards the river. Once you reach the water's edge you need to walk with the river on your left.

Continue along the Thames Path until you reach to Penton lock.

Here you can cross the lock and follow a path across the weir to reach Penton Hook Island.



Penton Hook Island is a wooded island with a mixture of both waterside and wooded trails for you and your pooches to enjoy. Off lead walks are fine here, but please be respectful of other dog owners, and as always, pick up after your pets.

Once you have finished exploring the island, retrace your steps back to the car parks.
