



HISTORY

THERE IS NO BETTER TIME OR PLACE TO EXPLORE THE WOMEN'S SUFFRAGE MOVEMENT THAN IN ROCHESTER, NEW YORK, IN 2020, THE 100TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE 19TH AMENDMENT. A NATIONAL FIGURE IN THE SUFFRAGE MOVEMENT, SUSAN B. ANTHONY SPENT HER MOST POLITICALLY ACTIVE YEARS HERE IN ROCHESTER AND HER LEGACY IS PRESERVED HERE TODAY. YOU CAN ALSO LEARN ABOUT HER FRIENDSHIP WITH FAMED ORATOR AND ABOLITIONIST FREDERICK DOUGLASS.

LANDMARKS

- DRIVE BY THE NATIONAL SUSAN B. ANTHONY MUSEUM AND HOUSE AT <u>17 MADISON STREET</u>
- STOP AT THE "LET'S HAVE TEA STATUE," LOCATED IN SUSAN B. ANTHONY SQUARE PARK, 39 KING STREET
- OUTSIDE OF THE 1872 CAFE, 431 WEST MAIN STREET, YOU CAN VISIT A REPLICA BALLOT BOX COMMEMORATING THE SPOT WHERE MS. ANTHONY CAST HER ILLEGAL VOTE IN THE 1872 PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION.
- MS. ANTHONY AND MR. DOUGLASS ARE BOTH INTERRED IN MOUNT HOPE CEMETERY, ONE OF THE MOST BEAUTIFUL VICTORIAN CEMETERY'S IN AMERICA, DATING BACK MORE THAN 175 YEARS, 1133 MOUNT HOPE AVENUE

MATH

MATH SURROUNDS YOUR EVERY DAY LIFE AND IS A PERFECT EXCUSE TO EXPLORE ROCHESTER IN SEARCH OF ANGLES, SHAPES, MEASUREMENTS AND MORE.

LANDMARKS

- KIDS OF ALL AGES SHOULD RECOGNIZE THE COLORFUL BLOCKS AND THE RIGHT ANGLES THAT THEY FORM THAT ARE BUILT INTO THE STRONG NATIONAL MUSEUM OF PLAY, 1 MANHATTAN SQUARE.
- EXPLORE HIGH FALLS FROM THE <u>PONT DE RENNES BRIDGE</u>. ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILDREN TO GUESS THE LENGTH AND USE TOOLS AT YOUR DISPOSAL TO MEASURE THE LENGTH OF THE BRIDGE (858 FEET). THE BRIDGE SITS 114 FEET ABOVE THE GORGE SO YOU CAN ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILDREN TO FIND OUT HOW MANY TIMES THAT HEIGHT FITS INTO THE LENGTH OF THE BRIDGE (7.5 TIMES). FUN FACT IF YOU TIPPED ROCKEFELLER CENTER IN NEW YORK CITY ON IT'S SIDE, IT WOULD BE THE SAME LENGTH AS THE BRIDGE!

SCIENCE

LIKE MATH, SCIENCE SURROUNDS YOUR EVERY DAY LIFE AND WITH SPRING UPON US, YOU'LL FIND MANY PLANTS AND FLOWERS IN BLOOM. VISIT ONE OF OUR MANY LOCAL PARKS FOR SOME FRESH AIR AND A REFRESHING HIKE TO EXPLORE NATURE AND ITS MANY LIVING ORGANISMS.

LANDMARKS

- DATING BACK TO 1888, HIGHLAND PARK IS ONE OF THE NATION'S FIRST ARBORETUMS AND WAS DESIGNED BY FAMED ARCHITECT FREDERICK LAW
 OLMSTEAD, MORE NOTABLY RECOGNIZED FOR DESIGNING NEW YORK CITY'S CENTRAL PARK. LILACS ARE JUST STARTING TO BLOOM AND YOU'LL FIND
 MORE THAN 500 DIFFERENT VARIETIES AND MORE THAN 1,200 BUSHES, 171 RESEVOIR AVENUE. YOU CAN ALSO EXPLORE THE HIGHLAND PARK RESEVOIR,
 AN ENLARGED NATURAL OR ARTIFICIAL LAKE, POND OR IMPOUNDMENT CREATED USING A DAM OR LOCK TO STORE WATER.
- HEAD DOWN TO MONROE COUNTY'S LARGEST PARK, MENDON PONDS, WHERE YOU'LL DISCOVER 2,500 ACRES OF WOODLANDS, PONDS, WETLANDS, AND GLACIALLY CREATED LANDFORMS. MENDON PONDS PARK WAS NAMED A NATIONAL NATURAL HISTORIC LANDMARK IN 1969 DUE TO ITS UNIQUE COMPLEX OF GLACIAL FEATURES.

GEOGRAPHY

THE GEOGRAPHY OF ROCHESTER WAS FORMED BY ICE SHEETS, DATING ALL THE WAY BACK TO THE ICE AGE WHICH RANGED FROM 2,580,000 TO 11,700 YEARS AGO! THE RETREATING AND MELTING OF ICE SHEETS DEPOSITED SEDIMENT THAT ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR SOME OF OUR HILLY TERRAIN INCLUDING MT. HOPE, THE HILLS OF HIGHLAND PARK, PINNACLE HILL AND COBBS HILL. THE ICE SHEETS ALSO DEVELOPED OUR MANY BODIES OF FRESH WATER, INCLUDING LAKE ONTARIO, THE GENESEE RIVER, IRONDEQUOIT BAY, SODUS BAY, MENDON PONDS AND THE NEARBY FINGER LAKES.

LANDMARKS

- LAKE ONTARIO IS THE EASTERN MOST OF THE FIVE GREAT LAKES AND THE ONLY TO NOT TOUCH THE STATE OF MICHIGAN, IT IS THE SMALLEST BY SURFACE SIZE (7,340 SQ. MI.) BUT EXCEEDS LAKE ERIE BY VOLUME (CU. MI.). IT IS THE 13TH LARGST LAKE IN THE WORLD AND SERVES AS AN OUTLET TO THE ATLANTIC OCEAN VIA THE ST. LAWRENCE SEAWAY. VISIT ONTARIO BEACH STATE PARK OR ENJOY A SCENIC DRIVE VIA THE SEAWAY TRAIL. FUN FACT A GREAT WAY TO REMEMBER ALL GIVE GREAT LAKES IS WITH THE MNEMONIC HOMES (HURON, ONTARIO, MICHIGAN, ERIE, SUPERIOR).
- WHERE ELSE THAN IN THE CITY OF ROCHESTER CAN YOU FIND A 96 FOOT WATERFALL. HIGH FALLS IS ONE OF THREE VOLUMINOUS WATERFALLS ON THE GENESEE RIVER AND HELPED SPUR THE EARLY INDUSTRIALIZATION OF ROCHESTER AS A LEADING MANUFACTURER OF FLOUR. THE GORGE SURROUNDING HIGH FALLS IS FILLED WITH SHALE, LIMESTONE, AND SANDSTONE WITH BANDS OF IRON ORE. TODAY THE FALLS PROVIDE HYDROELECTRIC POWER. THERE ARE SEVERAL VANTAGE POINTS INCLUDING THE PONT DE RENNES BRIDGE.

MUSIC

MUSIC IS ROOTED IN THE HISTORY OF ROCHESTER, THANKS IN PART TO THE GENEROSITY OF GEORGE EASTMAN. HE ESTABLISHED THE EASTMAN SCHOOL OF MUSIC IN 1921 AS PART OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ROCHESTER, AND TODAY THE SCHOOL RIVALS JUILLIARD AS THE BEST MUSIC SCHOOL IN THE COUNTRY.

LANDMARKS

- THE EASTMAN THEATER OPENED IN 1922 AS A PERFORMANCE VENUE FOR THE EASTMAN SCHOOL OF MUSIC WHICH OPENED AND HAS SERVED AS A PERFORMANCE VENUE FOR MUSIC, DANCE AND SILENT FILM WITH ORCHESTRAL AND ORGAN ACCOMPANIMENT. SOME OF THE WORLD'S GREATEST CONDUCTORS, COMPOSERS AND JAZZ MUSICIANS HAVE SHARED THE STAGE WITH EASTMAN SCHOOL OF MUSIC STUDENTS. ENJOY THE BEAUTIFUL MARQUEE AT 26 GIBBS STREET.
- NOT FAR FROM THE EASTMAN THEATER, AT <u>230-232 EAST AVENUE</u>, SITS THE LIDESTRI HOME AND FORMERLY THE SITE OF MUSIC AMERICA STUDIOS. METALLICA RECORDED THEIR DEBUT ALBUM THERE AND DOWN THE STREET AT THE ROCHESTER CLUB BALLROOM, <u>120 EAST AVENUE</u>, IN 1983.
- STOP BY MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. PARK, NEAR COURT STREET, WHERE YOU'LL FIND MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS THAT THE KIDS CAN PLAY.
- USING THE INTERNET, INTRODUCE YOUR CHILDREN TO FAMOUS ROCHESTER MUSICIANS INCLUDING: CAB CALLOWAY, LOU GRAMM, CHUCK AND GAP MANGIONE, RENÉE FLEMING AND MORE.

ART

ROCHESTER IS A RICH CREATIVE COMMUNITY WITH BEAUTIFUL ART AT EVERY TURN THAT INCLUDES PUBLIC ART, MURALS AND SCULPTURES.

LANDMARKS

- EXPLORE THE CENTENNIAL SCULPTURE PARK AT THE MEMORIAL ART GALLERY, 500 UNIVERSITY AVENUE. THIS TOWN SQUARE IN THE MIDDLE OF THE NEIGHBORHOOD OF THE ARTS INCLUDES PIECES SUCH AS SOLILOQUY, A 25 FOOT STAINLESS STEEL SCULPTURE AT THE CORNER OF GOODMAN AND UNIVERSITY BY FAMED ARTIST ALBERT PALEY AND CREATION MYTH BY TOM OTTERNESS. AMONGST ITS 17+ BRONZE MUSES IS SUSAN B. ANTHONY AND FRIEND ELIZABETH CADY STANTON WRITING A SUFFRAGE MOTTO.
- VARIOUS PROJECTS HAVE SET FORTH TO TRANSFORM THE MANY WALLS OF ROCHESTER THROUGH WORKS SUCH AS WALL\THERAPY, HER VOICE CARRIES AND ARTIST AND MURALIST SHAWN DUNWOODY.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

WITH MORE THAN 12,000 ACRES OF PARKLAND IN MONROE COUNTY AND 100+ MILES OF WELL-MARKED TRAILS, IT IS EASY TO ENJOY THE GREAT OUTDOORS FOR A LEISURELY WALK, HIKE, JOG OR BIKE RIDE.

LANDMARKS

- FOLLOW ALONG THE HISTORIC ERIE CANAL ON MORE THAN 100 LOCAL MILES OF FLAT, SAFE, AND EASILY ACCESSIBLE TRAIL WAY THAT CONNECTS THE GREAT LAKES TO THE ATLANTIC OCEAN VIA THE HUDSON RIVER. AN ENGINEERING MARVEL, THE CANAL HELPED ESTABLISH ROCHESTER AS THE FIRST BOOMTOWN IN THE UNITED STATES AND ESTABLISHED NEW YORK CITY AS A SHIPPING MECCA IN THE EARLY 1800'S. HISTORIC CANAL VILLAGES INCLUDE BROCKPORT, SPENCERPORT, FAIRPORT, PITTSFORD AND BUSHNELL'S BASIN.
- LEARN MORE ABOUT THE ERIE CANAL WITH A STROLL ALONG THE GENESEE RIVER IN WHICH THE CANAL INTERSECTS. A PROMENADE STYLE SECTION OF THE HISTORIC ERIE CANAL HERITAGE TRAIL AT <u>CORN HILL LANDING</u> FEATURES INTERPRETIVE SIGNAGE SHARING CANAL HISTORY AND ALSO OFFERS A GREAT VIEW OF THE ROCHESTER SKYLINE.
- EXPLORE <u>PLAY WALK</u>, A NEW INTERACTIVE CORRIDOR BETWEEN THE STRONG NATIONAL MUSEUM OF PLAY AND THE DOWNTOWN CENTRAL LIBRARY! YOU'LL FIND MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS, FOOSBALL, FOUR IN A ROW, DISTORTION MIRRORS AND MORE!
