CALL FOR ARTISTS

2020 CRE8IV: Transformational Art

The mission of CRE8IV as part of the Rockford Area Convention & Visitors Bureau Charitable Foundation Arts Fund is to encourage and enhance cultural life and public art in the Rockford region through facilitation, recognition, and financial support. The Arts Fund is looking to produce 3-5 (or more) murals throughout the Rockford region. The RACVB Charitable Foundation Arts Fund is soliciting artists with mural experience to produce large-scale works of art on exterior walls.

1. Location

The murals will be placed throughout downtown Rockford, Loves Park and Rockton, IL. Each location will be selected based on its high visibility, overall condition, neighborhood and overall pedestrian traffic.

2. Project Scope and Requirements

PUBLIC ART MURALS

The targeted locations are within an urban downtown area within Rockford, Loves Park or Rockton.. Sizes range from 20'X30' to 50'X100'

- Artists will be commissioned to exhibit original pieces or art.
- Works are required to be created with the best quality paints to help with longevity and overall look of piece.
- Murals that are vulgar, politically polarized, contain profanity or otherwise offensive language or symbols will not be considered.
- Content must be appropriate for all ages. The review committee reserves the right to inspect all pieces and instruct the removal of elements not approved in original sketch.

4. Publicity

Artist hereby grants RACVB a royalty free, worldwide, non-exclusive, non-transferable license to use images of the Artwork, for non-commercial purposes, to market, promote and advertise the exhibition of the Artwork..

Upon the installation of the Artwork, RACVB shall provide Artist with high-resolution digital images of the Artwork. RACVB hereby grants Artist a royalty free, worldwide, non-exclusive, non-transferable license to use the images of the Artwork provided by RACVB to Artist to market, promote and advertise the Artwork.

RACVB shall promote and publicize the exhibition of the Artwork, which shall include: (i) hosting a news conference to celebrate the installation of the Artwork, (ii) producing and distributing handouts/brochures with information about and images of the Artwork; (iii) contacting local and regional newspapers and media companies about the Artwork; (iv) inclusion in RACVB promotional materials including on www.gorockford.com and across its social media platforms.

5. Exhibition

The intent is to leave murals as a permanent piece of art for the foreseeable future. However, the building owner has the right to paint or change their wall as they see fit. There is no guarantee of longevity of the display.

6. Commission

Artists are required to submit a proposal along with all requirements for the project. This should be an itemized list that includes, lift needs, hotel accommodations, artist fee and paint stipend. The wall will be prepped and primed to the color of your choice prior to arrival.

If selected, the payment schedule is as follows:

25% will be paid upon signing contract 75% will be paid upon completion.

7. SCHEDULE

Application Deadline: Midnight, March 20, 2020

Review and Selection: March 21 – April 13, 2020

(Selected projects must be approved by Review Committee and City of Rockford)

Artist Notification: No later than April 30th, 2020

(Dependent on approvals from City Council and Zoning Board)

Installation Dates: Anticipated early to mid-June 2020

The RACVB Arts Fund reserves the right to update or revise the schedule, as necessary.

8. Selection

A selection panel composed of community members and facilitated by the RACVB Charitable Foundation Arts Fund will choose the finalists. Artists will be contacted once the decision has been made in a timely fashion to allow for planning of installation of sculpture.

Selection criteria including but are not limited to:

- Creates a sense of joy for those viewing the piece
- Suitable for all audiences
- Represents diverse and inclusive content
- Artist reputation, resume, exhibition history
- Overall appeal and aesthetic quality

9. Application
