

# 1.) GRAMERCY

To kick off our mural project, Experience Roseburg was lucky to have Raymond Argumedo of Gramercy Art Company contribute to the project. His work combines Art Nouveau influences with elements of Pacific Northwest nature, myth, and space. His piece can be found on the back wall of The Wine Destination — in the brick walkway between the downtown parking garage and Jackson Street.

## 2.) RATHER SEVERE

Our second wall was a massive, weeklong undertaking by the artist team Jon Stommel and Travis Czekalski known as "Rather Severe." Experience Roseburg was thrilled to host the two Portland-based artists and to see their interpretation of the Roseburg area. The piece can be found by the back entrance of North Forty Beer Co. — on the north wall by Main Street. Completed on August 17, 2022.

### 3.) FOREST WOLF KELL

Experience Roseburg was excited to host artist Forest Kell of Portland whose illustration style offers a fresh perspective of the area. The public was invited to see the live mural painting

on Saturday, October 8, during the downtown Blocktober Fest event. As described by Kelf, "ultimately my art practice acts as a tool for expression and introspection. Each composition is constructed with arrangements of representations of objects and symbols, which derive meaning through each piece's relationship to the things placed around it and within the context of a whole." The mural is located on the north wall of Old Soul Pizza. Completed on October 11, 2022.

#### 4.) HANNAH EDDY

Experience Roseburg's first mural of 2023 was completed by artist Hannah Eddy — based out of Reno, Nevada. Her expressive graphic style and free-thinking approach to art is heavily influenced by the skateboard/snowboard/surf culture that she grew up immersed in. The mural is located on the east wall of the Grand Apartments.

Completed on August 4, 2023.

# 5.) OLIVER CASILLAS

The fifth mural in our mural project was painted by Oliver Casillas and completed in early October 2023. It's located at: 1021 SE Washington Ave. The mural depicts local wildlife

including a Chinook salmon and white-tailed deer. The color palette is evocative of Casillas' other works. The mural wall shares space with a major downtown parking lot and is across the street from the Post Office and just around the corner from the "Old Soul Mural".

## 6.) KATIE & KAREN

The mural work is rooted in a shared intention: to notice beauty everywhere we go-and to help others see it too. Whether it's a patch of poppies growing on the side of the road or a sweeping mountain view, we're drawn to the small, meaningful details that make a place feel alive. Katie and Karen's Roseburg mural, Notice Beauty, is a love letter to the region's gorgeous natural landscape. Set against the backdrop of Toketee Falls, the piece features a cascade of local flora and fauna—including a western tanager, swallowtail butterfly, foxglove, fireweed, trillium, columbine, and mushrooms-each element carefully chosen to reflect the vibrancy of this place. It's our hope that this mural brings a sense of wonder to the community and encourages everyone who passes by to slow down, look closely, and truly notice the beauty

that surrounds them. Completed on June 22, 2025.

# 7.) NOWHERE LAND

Brooks Engel is an illustrator and designer based in Denver, Colorado fueled by adventure, bold graphics, and handcrafted art inspired by the outdoors, pop culture, and anything with skulls on it. For the past 10 years he has been creating art under the name Nowhere Land, where he works with small and large businesses to design custom apparel, beer labels. branding, and everything in between. His art encourages exploration and self-expression, inviting people to embrace their "Nowhere I and"—a place of personal discovery. Completed on June 22, 2025.
