Convention Center

On December 12, City Council approved plans to move forward with the revised design of the Sacramento Convention Center, which will include a new second-floor ballroom and meeting room space on the west side. With the addition of the second-floor ballroom, City staff also recommended an alternative schedule, which was approved and will revise the start date for the Convention Center to January 2019 when work will begin on the exterior east side of the building. The Convention Center will shut for construction in mid-July 2019 and will reopen in November 2020.

An update on private operations was provided. City staff expects to receive a full proposal by January 15. After City review and outreach, a recommendation will be brought to City Council in Spring 2018.
