Memorial Auditorium

On Feb. 27, the California Infrastructure and Economic Development Bank (iBank) approved the City's loan for \$15 million dollars for the Memorial Auditorium Renovation Project. The project is currently out to bid and will close on Mar. 15. Construction will begin in late June of 2018 and will be completed by May of 2019. Staff will seek approval from City Council in late May for an agreement with a contractor.

Community Center Theater

On Feb.28, the steering committee reconvened to review the Community Center Theater Renovation budget. DLR/Westlake Reed Leskosky (project architect) provided an update to the steering committee. The project team has developed a value engineering plan to bring the project back within budget. Some of the VE items were identified as add alternates, such as the multi-purpose room, which would be brought back into the project if sufficient savings are achieved. The steering committee had an opportunity to prioritize these add alternate items and these items will be considered as the budget allows.
