Sacramento Convention Center

The City of Sacramento and AECOM Hunt, the project contractor, reached an agreement for the Guaranteed Maximum Price for the construction of the Sacramento Convention Center Expansion and Renovation Project. On Nov. 13, City Council approved the agreement. Construction work will begin with the demolition of the Convention Center Administration Offices at the corner of 15th and K streets, which will begin in December 2018. Construction work will begin on the convention center when it closes in July 2019. The facility will reopen in November 2020, and final completion of the project is scheduled for spring 2021.
