


# OUTSIDE THE ORDINARY

## Live Music & Festivals

Sacramento is THE West Coast music festival destination, especially in the fall when multi-day rock, country, americana and hip hop/R&B festivals all bring top talent to the city. Even when there's no major festival in town, a host of other venues are bringing exciting shows, from major acts at Golden 1 Center to classic favorites and up-and-coming talent at a range of smaller venues.



## Sacramento Kings

The NBA's Kings call Sacramento home, playing their games in the heart of the city at Golden 1 Center. Nowhere are the fans louder, and when the kings win, there's nothing like the excitement as we light the beam.

## Sacramento River Cats

The Sacramento River Cats are the Triple-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants and play at Sutter Health Park, just across Tower Bridge from downtown Sacramento, providing the perfect backdrop as the sun sets on warm summer nights and you enjoy America's pastime. Sutter Health Park is also home to the MLB's A's for at least three years beginning in 2025.



## Sacramento Republic FC

The capital's professional soccer team has called Sacramento home for more than a decade. Winning the championship in their first year, the excitement has never tapered off, and the matches are held just a few minutes from the heart of downtown Sacramento.


## 5 Land Park


## 2 Discovery Park

## Old Sacramento

**The Old Sacramento Waterfront is a vibrant 28-acre National Historic Landmark District and State Historic Park that honors California's beginning.**

Nestled along the scenic Sacramento River, the district is bustling with shops, restaurants, entertainment, historical attractions, and museums from the California Gold Rush and Transcontinental Railroad. Explore dozens of recreated or restored Gold Rush-era buildings, with wooden sidewalks and horse-drawn carriages throughout.

## Golden 1 Center

**Golden 1 Center is Sacramento's premier entertainment venue, hosting A-list musicians, comedians, and events year-round.**

Home to the Sacramento Kings, Golden 1 Center is the most technologically advanced arena in the NBA. The arena is the heart of a revitalized downtown core that is surrounded by lively dining and shopping options.
